## The issue

In the context of rising numbers of unemployment benefit applicants, longer unemployment spells and increasing numbers of job seekers who do not qualify for unemployment benefits, national and sub-national governments need to apply the right mix of policies, which can be difficult to decide upon. Choices are also constrained by reduced budgets. Employment and social policies and local strategies have to reconcile the need to prevent the loss of skills and get the highly skilled back into employment while also targeting the at-risk groups and providing adequate safety nets to job losers and low income families. It is important to address the immediate needs while also setting the ground for quality employment in the future.

## The seminar

**Day 1:** The seminar will start with an assessment of the impact of the crisis on the labour market and discuss, using concrete examples, the value of various policy responses on the basis of three critical trade-offs:

1. Investing in “winners” vs. reducing redundancies
2. Are “green” jobs really an answer?
3. Targeting the disadvantaged vs. supporting the easy to support

**Days 2 and 3** will build your knowledge on:

1. Tools and methods to measure local labour market trends, identify problems, prepare a diagnostic as a basis for strategy design
2. Ways to adapt labour market policy to local needs
3. Ways to integrate different instruments into a coherent local skills strategy

The OECD experts and your peers from other countries will also advise you on the challenges faced in your locality.

## Who

Policy makers and practitioners directly involved in designing and putting in place local strategies to respond to rising unemployment (national and regional authorities, local employment services, ministries of labour, education and training institutions, regional development agencies, local partnerships ...).

## How

The capacity building session will begin with a one-day seminar open to a wider audience of policymakers and practitioners involved in tackling the impact of the crisis on jobs and skills: government officers, city officials, trade unions, researchers.

Day 2 and 3 will be structured around a mix of presentations by invited experts and OECD staff followed by discussion and group work around case studies developed by participants prior to the seminar.

### THEMATIC DISCUSSION 1: INVESTING IN “WINNERS” V.S. REDUCING REDUNDANCIES

Localities are confronted with difficult choices about how to respond to the crisis, especially in the context of constrained budgets. Some are supporting the “winners” (e.g. strong enterprises whose high growth potential is constrained by credit crunch) that would potentially pull the local economy out of recession and provide stable employment in the future. At the same time, the need to support large employers and help prevent major lay-offs is also obvious and automotive industry support packages are part of the anti-crisis responses in many regions. What are the first results of these measures in terms of employment? How active labour market policies can support these measures? What is the role of the local level? How can short-term working subsidies be effectively combined with initiatives to support education, training and work experience at the local level. What new governance mechanisms are needed?

**THEMATIC DISCUSSION 2: ARE “GREEN” JOBS REALLY AN ANSWER?**

A great deal has been said about the potential of the “green” economy to support job creation and effectively absorb stimulus measures (investment in climate friendly infrastructure, R&D in green technologies; and innovation of education and training systems). However, not everybody will gain through such investment, with some sectors winning and others losing. Anticipating change, adjusting training and educational provisions to new needs, building a local strategy around climate-friendly industries and jobs ... how to reconcile these longer term goals with the urgent need to respond to rising unemployment at local level? How can greener economy generate some short-term impacts? What is the role of local intermediaries and stakeholders?

**THEMATIC DISCUSSION 3: TARGETING THE DISADVANTAGED VS SUPPORTING THE EASY-TO- REACH**

The crisis is affecting both high and low skilled workers and is making it even more difficult for disadvantaged groups to retain or regain employment. In the context of rising numbers of unemployment benefit applicants, longer unemployment spells and increasing numbers of job seekers who do not qualify for unemployment benefits, national and sub-national governments need to apply the right mix of policies, which can be difficult to decide upon. These policies need to reconcile the need to get larger numbers of skilled people back into employment while also targeting at-risk groups and providing adequate safety nets to job losers and local income families. What sort of partnerships are necessary at the local level to ensure that all local people remain economically active and effectively engaged in upgrading their skills through the crisis?
