

**Bio: Antonio Rosati**

Antonio Rosati (Rome, 1957) is the Financial and Balance Commissioner of the Province of Rome, appointed by the President Enrico Gasbarra in 2003 and confirmed in role by the President Nicola Zingaretti in 2008.

He is the National Coordinator of the Financial and Balance Council of the Italian Union of Provinces and member (since 2009) of the Presidential Board of Legautonomie, participating in the City-State Conference and in the Parliamentary meeting on the regional and local government issues.

In 1993 Rosati was elected in the Roman City Council; confirmed in the general elections of 1997, he has been for three years head of the delegation of the Democratic Left Party.

Before assuming his role in the Province of Rome, from 2000 to 2003 Rosati has been President of Risorse per Roma s.p.a. the Roman City Council Society for the investments in the public estate and heritage.
