- **tackle** discrimination, vulnerability and exclusion



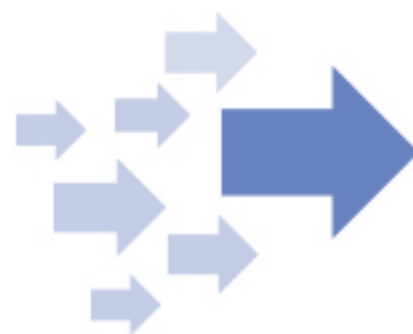
