


*A New Evidence on Demand E-Learning Course on Enhancing Capacity for Environmental Management, Climate Change Adaptation, Low Carbon Development and Governance*



This entry level foundation course is aimed at development professionals, including DFID staff, working in fields other than climate and environment who would benefit from a core understanding of the principles of greening development. The interactive course leads students through the OECD's Five-Step Framework for Greening Development, focusing on greening of national development processes, greening of national budgetary processes, and greening of key economic sectors.

Participants will progress by helping Lili edit a newspaper, put together a website and anchor a television news show on the issues of mainstreaming environment and climate change issues in national development processes and interventions for poverty reduction.
