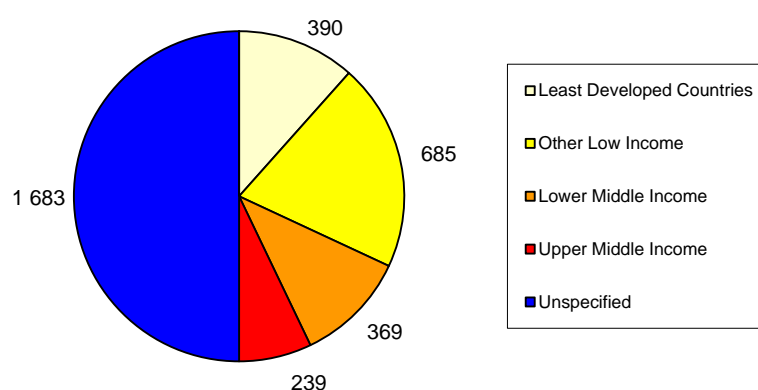

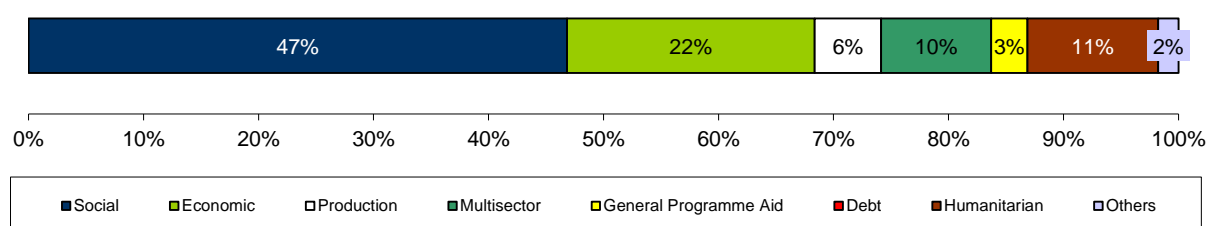

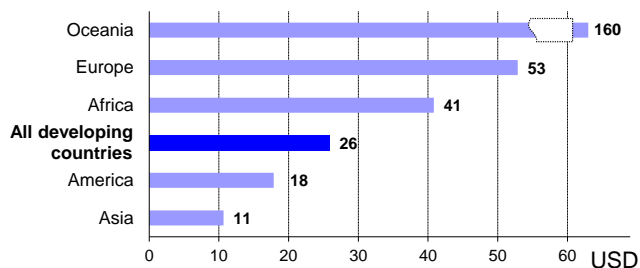

### 6.1.5. Sectors in 2016 commitments



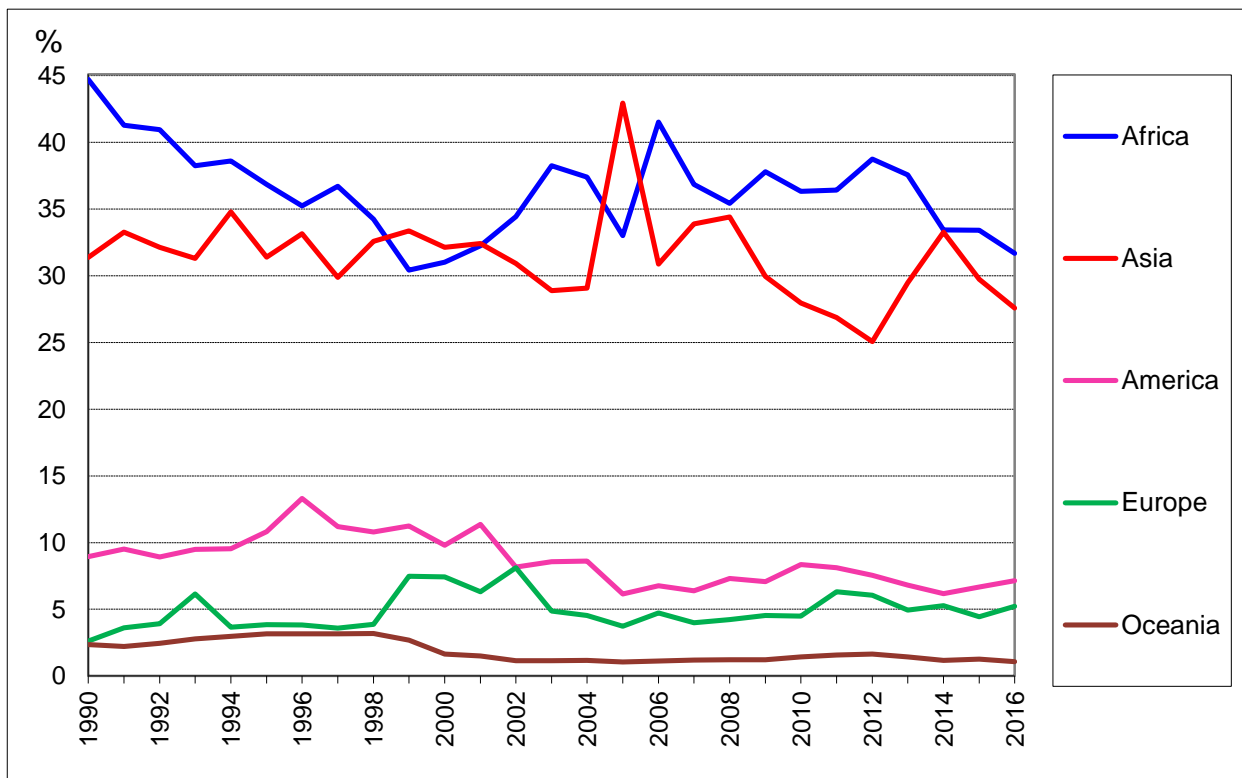
**6.1.6. Net ODA receipts per capita in 2016**

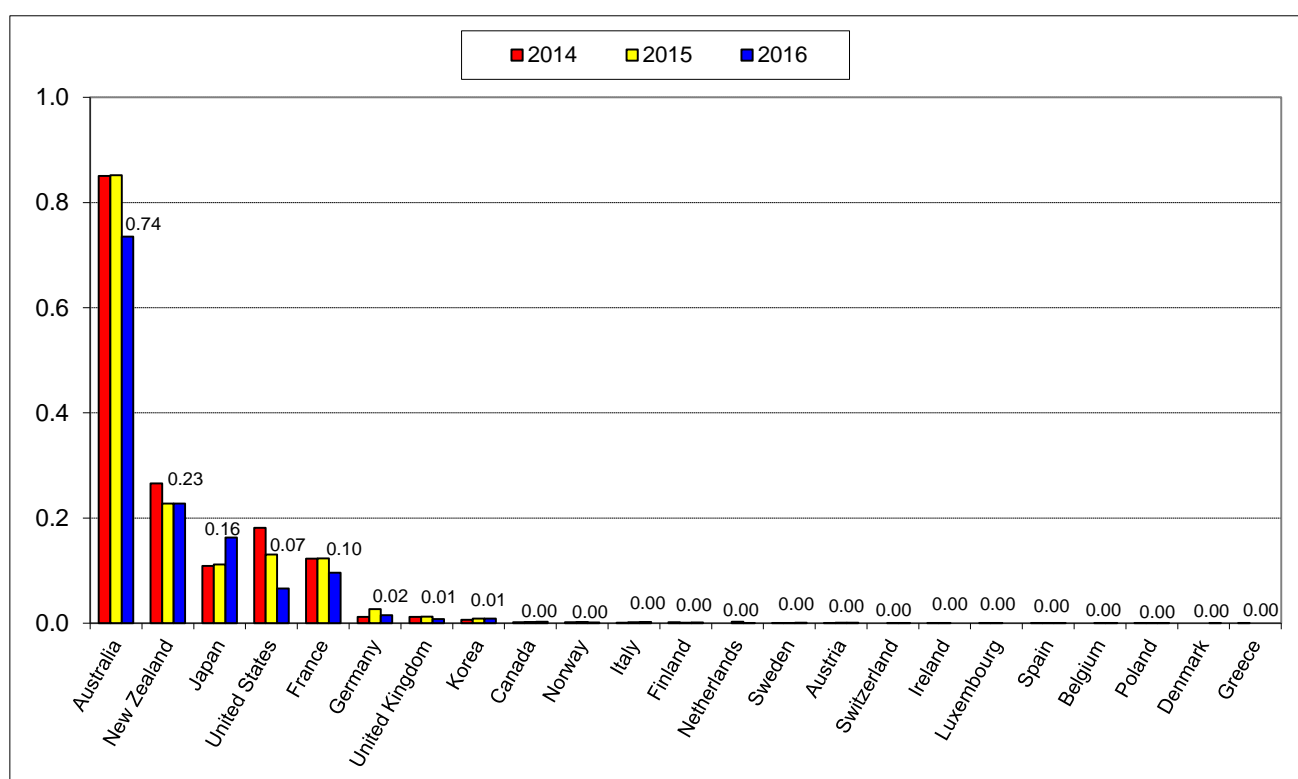

USD billion, values shown for 2016, net bilateral disbursements



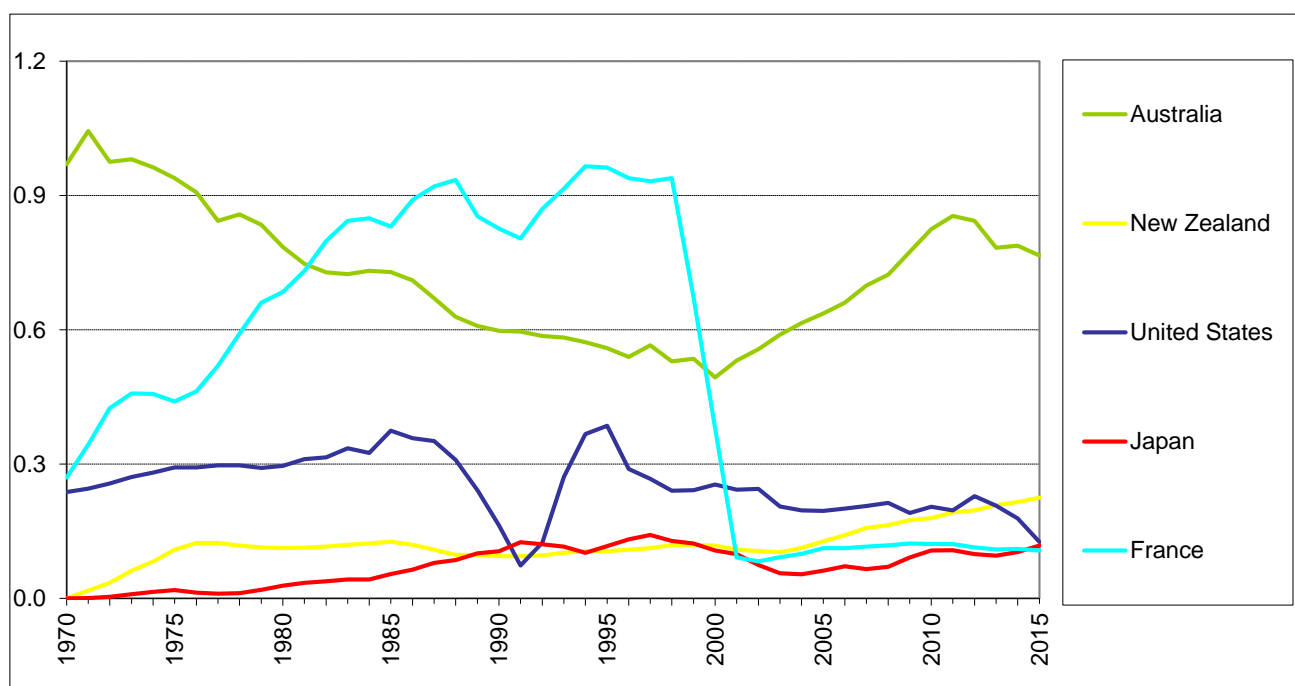

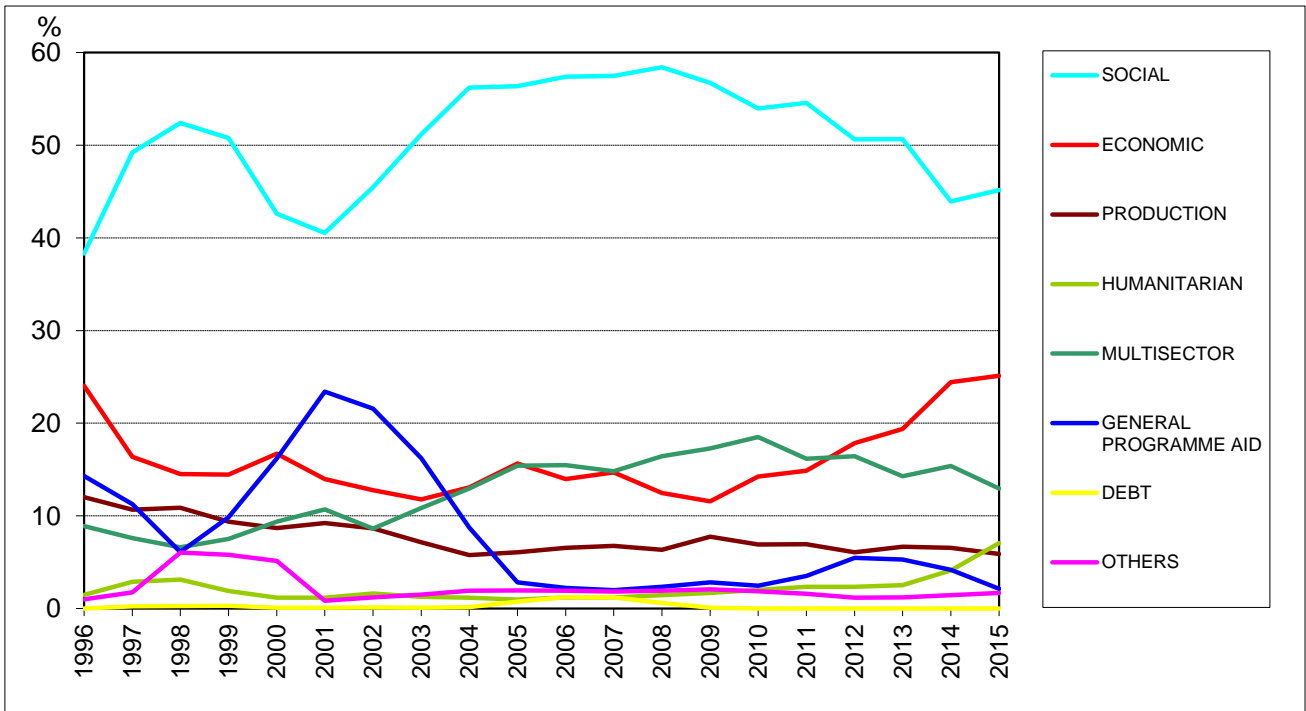
**6.2.8. Trends in aid to largest Oceanian recipients since 1970**

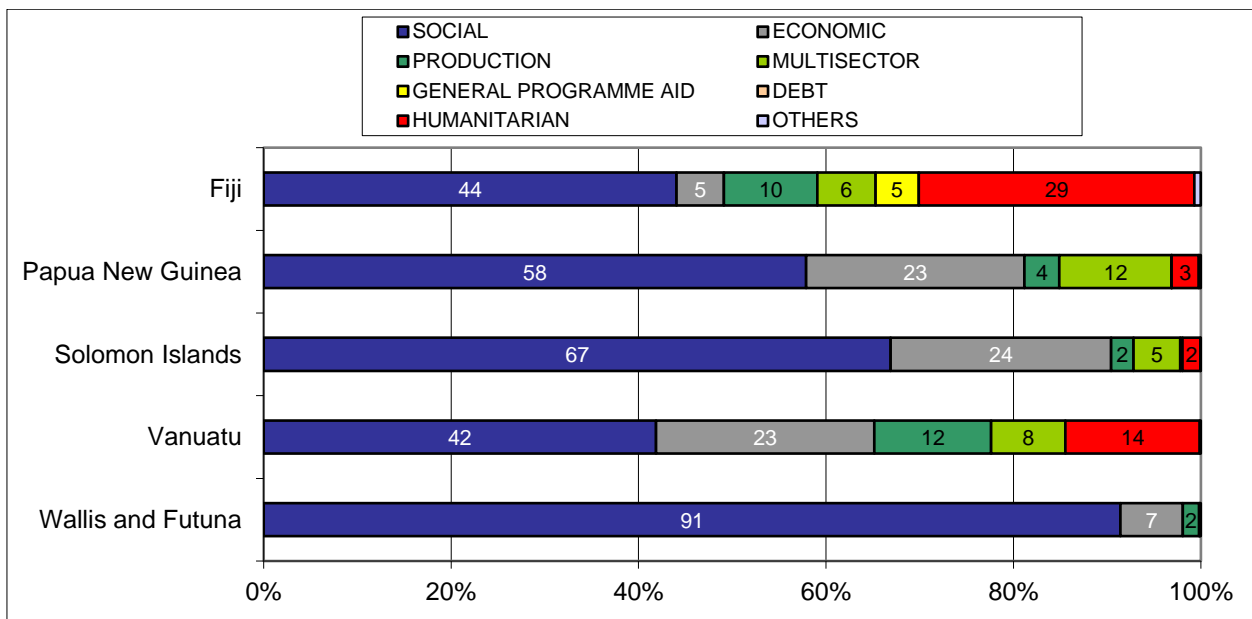
### 6.3.1. ODA to Oceania by sector since 1996

As a percentage of total ODA committed for each country





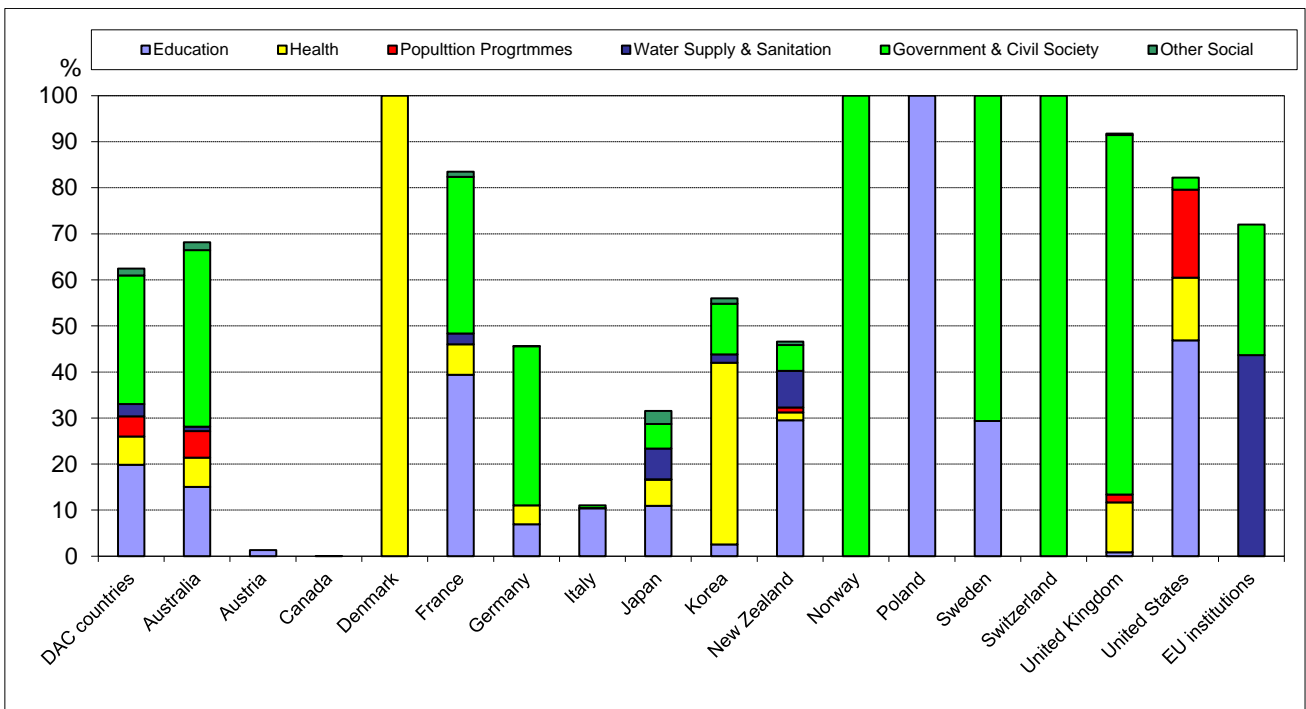
