1973-2013, 5-year moving average commitments, constant 2013 prices

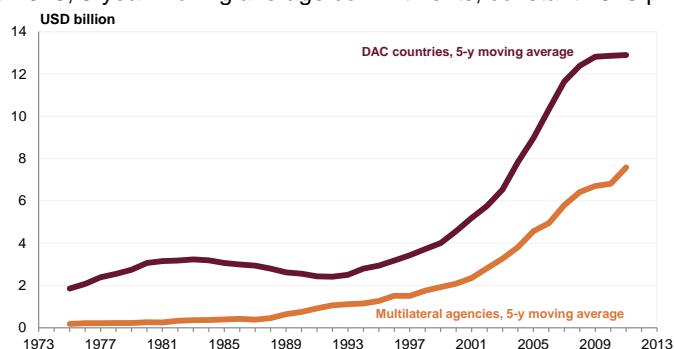

2012-13, bilateral and multilateral commitments, constant 2013 prices

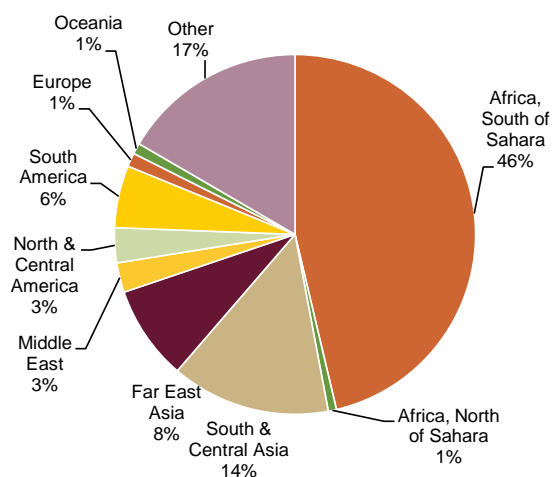


Chart 3. Sub-sectoral breakdown of aid to Health
2012-13, bilateral and multilateral commitments, constant 2013 prices

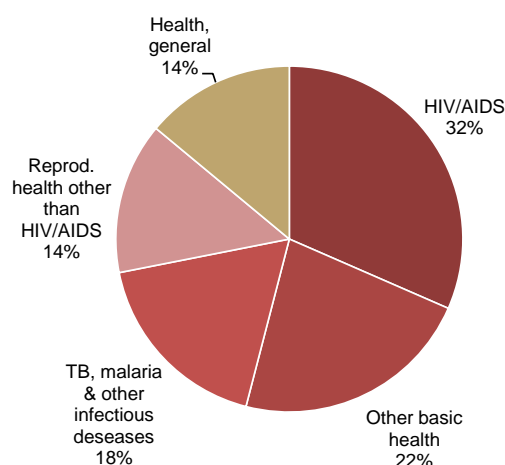


Chart 4. Total flows to Health: grants, loans and non-concessional flows
2012-13, bilateral and multilateral commitments, constant 2013 prices

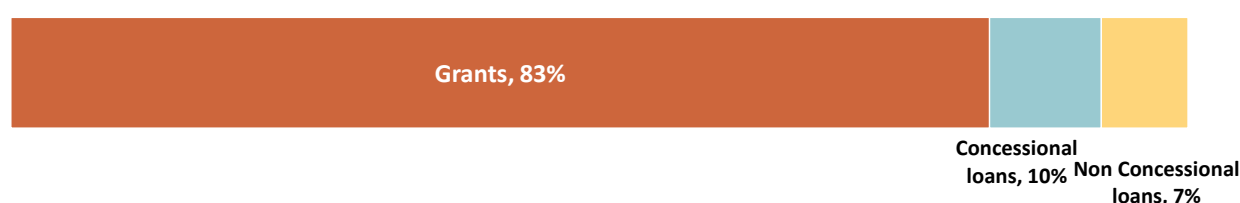
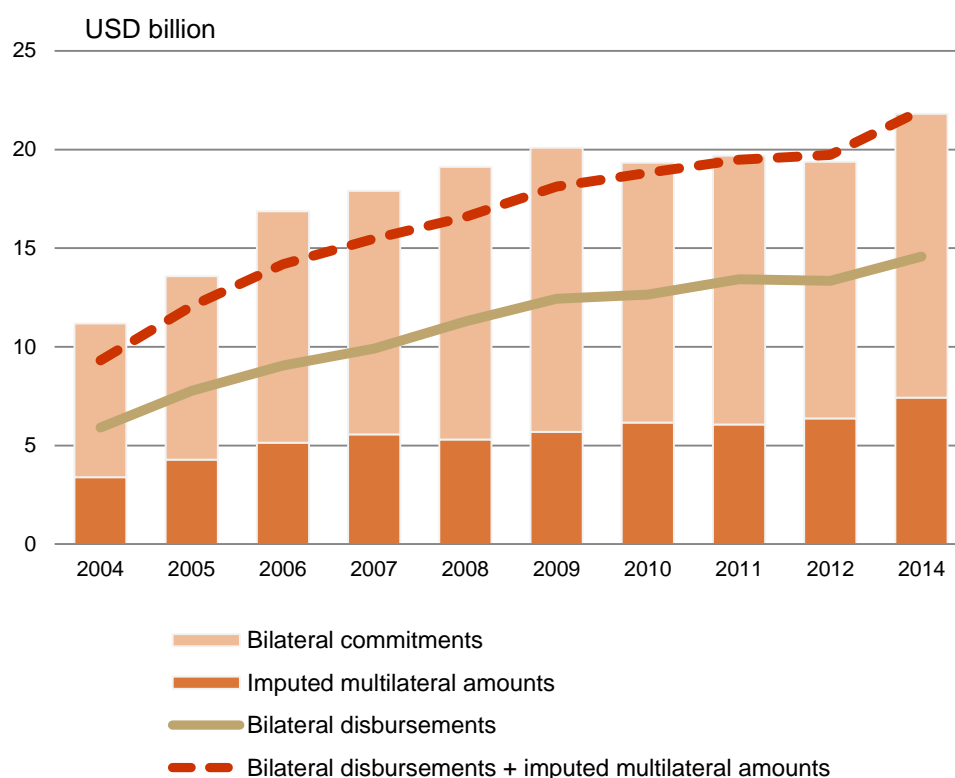
