2. EXCHANGE LOCAL CURRENCY

WHEN ALL OF YOU GET OUT OF THE AIRPORT, THE FIRST THING YOU SHOULD DO IN VIETNAM IS CHANGING MONEY.

In Vietnam, people only use Vietnam Dong, therefore if you need money for transportation, you can go to the nearest bank located at the airport. You can easily see the bank when you are get out of the entrance.

The exchange rate of [Dong is 22.000 VND ~ 1\\$](#), please calculate and check the money carefully when you left the bank.

3. TAKING TAXI FROM AIRPORT TO HOTEL

If you want to take Taxi from Hotel to the other place, please take the TAXI METER: TAXI HANOI CP or MAI LINH TAXI.

These are the best two TAXI with a good quality in HANOI. Because in Hanoi now, there are more than 50 Taxi companies from the big company to private company. So it's really difficult to distinguish them, so the best advice is when you are in Hanoi, take two TAXI company below.

At the moment, there are 4-6 branch companies of TAXI at NOI BAI International Airport, the most popular is NOIBAI TAXI with the hotline number is +84 43 868888. The other branch name like AIPORT TAXI (04) 3.762.1903 or DAINAM Taxi and NOIBAI CONNECT is also good.

For further information, you can ask directly the TAXI services at the airport or the Information Boot. All of the TAXI companies have Agency inside Noi Bai Airport

Remember NOT to take taxi with no name tag on the car or get on a TAXI that the driver try to beg or ask you to come, that would be a fake TAXI with the expensive rate. So Just take the TAXI from 4 above companies.

When you are on the taxi, tell the Taxi driver to go to Sheraton Hanoi Hotel, K5 Nghi Tam, 11 Xuan Dieu Road, Tay Ho District, Hanoi, Vietnam

PRICE OF TAKING TAXI:

Usually the price of taxi from AIRPORT to SHERATON HOTEL is around 350.000-400.000 (around 20\$) and the price of Taxi from Hanoi city to the Airport is much cheaper (around 250.000 for Airport Taxi not the METER TAXI)


Sedan service, accommodating three to four guests is available. Choose from a Ford Mondeo, BMW 5 Series or BMW 520i.

- Taxis are an excellent way to get around Hanoi and visit the area's top destinations. Fares vary based on destination, but a ride to Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum is approximately 1.5 USD while a trip to the City Centre and Hoan Kiem Lake are approximately 5 USD. Taxis are available around the clock.

- See all that Hanoi has to offer with our private car service. Our experienced drivers are available for transfers within the city and beyond.

Hourly rentals are available for excursions within 15km of the hotel. Rates are 25 USD per hour, with a two-hour minimum. Beyond this distance, additional fees apply.

Popular destinations outside of the city include Bat Trang Village (100 USD), Dong Mo Golf (150 USD), and Ha Long (320 USD).

All fees are round trip ride in a four-seat vehicle, including tax and service charges. In case of an overnight trip, an additional 60 USD surcharge will be applied.

We request that guests make arrangements at the Concierge Desk at least four hours in advance of anticipated departure time. However, all guests will be accommodated based upon availability.



5. Local Area

The bustling Old Quarter has been a cauldron of commerce for 800 years and is still the best place to check the pulse of the resurgent city.
