Most Australians would have seen the “Understanding Money” campaign run on TV, magazines and newspapers.

He is Chairman of Money magazine, Chairman of the youth anti-drink driving body and is also a Council Member of Philanthropy Australia.

In 2008 Paul was invited by the Federal Government to the 2020 Summit as a member of the Future of the Australian Economy Committee.
