

Thomas Wieser , an Austrian national, was born in the US (Bethesda, Md) in 1954. His present post is Director General for Economic Policy and Financial Markets in the Ministry of Finance, Vienna. His Department is in charge of macro-economic policy, international and EU affairs, financial market legislation, and export credits and guarantees.

After a degree in Economics (University of Innsbruck) he pursued post-graduate studies in theoretical and mathematical economics, and taught, at the University of Colorado, Boulder (Fulbright scholarship) and the Institute of Advanced Studies, Vienna.

Prior to his appointment in the Ministry of Finance he spent 4 years as an economist in EFTA in Geneva, where he also was in charge of negotiations with the EU on state aid affairs. Prior to that he worked in banking in Vienna, and as a research economist.

Mr. Wieser has published articles in journals and periodicals on national and international economic policy issues; he is member of the Supervisory Boards of economic research institutes and the Oesterreichische Nationalbank (Austrian Central Bank). He is Vice-Chair of the Economic and Financial Committee of the EU, and Chair of the OECD Committee on Financial Markets.
