

Jane Nash – Biographical Notes

Jane Nash is Head of Government & Regulatory Affairs at ANZ Banking Group, one of four major banking groups in Australia. Government and Regulatory Affairs has responsibility for managing ANZ's corporate relationships and issues with governments and regulators.

Jane led work on the first national survey of adult financial literacy in Australia published in 2003. Since then she has led work on a second national survey of financial literacy and ground-breaking research into consumer financial difficulty in Australia. Both studies were published in 2005.

Educated at Melbourne University where she completed a Bachelor of Commerce (Honours) degree, Jane started her career as an economist at the State Bank of Victoria. In mid-1991 she joined ANZ. At ANZ, Jane has worked in a number of roles including as an economist, in the areas of marketing and distribution strategy and in Investor Relations. In 2005 Jane completed an Executive MBA at INSEAD.
