David Tuesta Cardenas is Chief Economist of the Pension Unit of BBVA in Madrid. He has been working for BBVA since 2000, first in Lima as Chief Economist of Peru and then as Chief Economist of Global Trends.

Before working for BBVA he works for the Ministry of Treasury in Peru as Chief Economist of the Tax Agency, from 1992 to 2000. Before that, he works as Public Finance Specialist at APOYO consulting, one of the most relevant leading think tanks in Latin America.

Mr. Tuesta has been one of the five members of the Board of Directors of the National Energy Regulator in Peru from 2006 to 2009 and consultant for the Inter American Development Bank-IDB for the Ministry of Treasury of Paraguay in Asuncion. From 1997 until 2009 he was professor of the Faculty of Economics of the Catholic University of Peru and the Graduate School of the University of Lima.

David Tuesta is an Economist from the Catholic University of Peru and holds a Master Degree in Public Affairs and Economics from the University of Minnesota. His research -mainly focused in public finance, fiscal decentralization, pensions and banking- has been published in books and specialized journals.
