

## **DR. L STEPHEN COLES, M.D., PH.D**

Dr. L Stephen Coles, M.D., Ph.D. is a Co-Founder and Director of the Los Angeles Gerontology Research Group (GRG) and a Director of the Supercentenarian Research Foundation (SRF). He is a Director of the Los Angeles Chapter of Physicians for Social Responsibility (PSR). He served as an Assistant Researcher in the Department of Surgery at the UCLA David Geffen School of Medicine, a Visiting Scholar in the UCLA Department of Computer Science, and is currently a Lecturer in the UCLA Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry (Molecular Biology Institute) as well as a Visiting Scholar in the Stanford University Department of Developmental Biology. Dr. Coles is the author or co-author of 163 scientific papers and holds two patents.

He received his B.S. in Electrical Engineering from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York, his Master's in Mathematics from the Carnegie Institute of Technology, and his Ph.D. in Systems and Communication Sciences from Carnegie-Mellon University in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. His thesis work was in Computational Linguistics under Prof. Herbert A. Simon, a Nobel Prize winner in Economics.

After attending Stanford University Medical School, Dr. Coles completed his Clinical Internship in OB/GYN at the Jackson Memorial Hospital of the University of Miami School of Medicine. He has taught at Stanford and UC Berkeley. Dr. Coles also served as a Lecturer at UCLA, USC, and CalTech.
