Andrew Donaldson

Andrew Donaldson studied at the University of Stellenbosch, UNISA and Cambridge University.

He taught Economics at the former University of Transkei, Rhodes University and the University of the Witwatersrand.

He joined the then Department of Finance in 1993, and is currently Deputy Director-General responsible for Public Finance in the National Treasury. He oversees the Treasury's work on spending policy, social development and public service delivery, and has played a leading role in the reform of the budget process and reshaping of budget documentation.

He contributed to the work of the Katz Commission on tax policy, served on the Committee of Inquiry into a National Health Insurance System, was a member of the team that drafted the 1996 macroeconomic strategy and is currently involved in the Interdepartmental Task Team on Social Security and Retirement Reform.

He is a former member of the Board of Directors of the South African National Roads Agency and the Board of Trustees of the Government Employees' Pension Fund.
