OECD Council provides high-level mandate to the OECD Investment Committee (IC) and Development Assistance Committee (DAC) to monitor the implementation of the Recommendation on Due Diligence Guidance

IC and DAC approve work plan for 2011-2012 to set up multi-stakeholder working groups to negotiate the Gold Supplement and carry out the reporting activity for 3T Supplement, as well as joint ICGLR-OECD-WB studies on role of donors and feasibility study

Possible Governance Structure of the OECD Due Diligence Initiative

- **Chairs?** E.g. Co-chairs/Co-Facilitators from OECD and partner countries, industry and NGOs on a rotating basis
- **Representation and size?** E.g. Equal representation from OECD and non-OECD countries, industry (throughout the supply chains, and different sectors) and civil society (international and local)
- **Functions?** E.g. Provide the strategic orientation from the development of the Initiative; sets meeting agendas, identify issues of cross-cutting relevance, carry out outreach missions
- **Decision-making?** E.g. Decision taken by consensus
