

Michael Kahn

Prof. Michael Kahn is Senior Research Fellow in the Centre for Research on Science and Technology of the University of Stellenbosch and Professor Extraordinaire at the Tshwane University of Technology, Pretoria, South Africa

He was formerly Executive Director of Knowledge Systems and the founding Head of the Centre for Science, Technology and Innovation Indicators (CeSTII) at the Human Sciences Research Council.

As Head of CeSTII he was responsible for establishing, designing and conducting the official R&D and Innovation surveys.

He has played a key role in developing innovation policy and for South Africa, as well as further afield within the NEPAD and African Union S&T initiatives, both as analyst and trainer. His contributions to policy include drafting the Green and White Papers on S&T, leading the initial phase of the National Research and Technology Foresight study and writing the Foresight Synthesis Report. Other contributions are the Performance Measurement System for the Science Councils, the *Flight of the Flamingoes* study on researcher mobility, and a study on the benefits of publicly-funded R&D for the National Advisory Council on Innovation.

Prof. Kahn is a member of the Academy of Sciences of South Africa, serves on the advisory board of the journal *Research Policy*, and is a board member of the Agriculture Research Council.
