

Jean Guinet is Head of the Country Review Unit at the OECD Directorate for Science, Technology and Industry. His main interests are the contribution of technological change and innovation to economic performance, and the monitoring and assessment of science, technology and innovation policy of OECD Member and selected non-member countries. Over the last ten years he managed or made important contributions to many major OECD projects, notably: National innovation Systems; Technology, Productivity and Job Creation; the Growth Study; Industry-Science Relationships; Public Private Partnerships for Innovation; Evaluation of Publicly Funded Research; Globalisation of R&D.
