E-Government: Achievements

- Reviewing, Updating and Development of some laws and legislations that are crucial to support e-government implementation.
- Completion of the selected e-services at the:
 - DVLD (Drivers and Vehicles Licensing Department).
 - DLS (Department of Lands and Survey).
- Development of the new e-government strategy and roadmap (2007-2009).
- Development of e-government services Management strategy and e-government Training strategy.
- Launching of the e-government Portal (Information phase)



E-Government: Achievements, cont...

- Development of other sub-strategies such as (connectivity strategy, hosting strategy)
- Training completion for a number of government employees on:
 - Basic IT literacy.
 - Specialized programs related to business and technology.
 - Development of the Change Management Kit to be used by other government entities
- Connectivity of 18 government entity on the SGN (Secured Government Network).



E-Government: Outlook

- E-Payment Gateway
- SGN III – entities connectivity, another 30 entities (Q1 2009)
- National Smart ID Card System (Q2 2009)
- Issuing visas e-services (Q1 2009)
- A number of cross e-services:
 - Issuing of Vocational Licenses e-services (Q3 2008)
 - E-Services at the Sales tax Department (Q3 2008)



E-Government: Outlook

- Development of Business Continuity Plan
- Employees' Selection e-services (Q2 2009)
- Registering life events and Issuing passports e-services (Q2 2010)



Management of Public Expenditure: Achievements

- Introduction of MTFF.
- Introduction of MTEF for budget 2008-2010.
- Introduction of results oriented budgeting.
- A new chart of accounts.
- Improvement of tax management.
- First round of public expenditure review.



Management of Public Expenditure: Outlook

- GFMIS: first stage 2008.
- Treasury single account: second stage 2008, third stage 2009.



Promoting Public–Private Partnership: Achievements

- Privatization Law that was enacted in 2001 covers public-private partnership.
- PPP Strategy and policy were approved by the government.
- EPC was designated as the authority in charge of PPP program.
- To set a good example, two projects were tendered recently: Amman-Zarqa rail way, and the extension of QAIA.



Promoting Public–Private Partnership: Outlook

- PPP Management structure is being setup.
- PPP fund will be launched in the near future.
- 15 projects will be identified to be implemented over the next 3 to 4 years with an estimated cost around 4 billion dollars.
