

Jørgen Elmeskov is Director of the Policy Studies Branch of the OECD Economics Department. He has worked in the OECD since 1986 in various capacities, being associated, *inter alia*, with the OECD Jobs Strategy, the OECD Growth Project and the Organisation's work on climate change and on globalisation. He also chaired the editorial board of *OECD Economic Studies*. He was a Member of the Danish Government's Welfare Commission, whose proposals triggered recent retirement reforms. He is currently a Member of the Danish government's Climate Commission. Mr. Elmeskov is of Danish nationality and has a Masters Degree in Economics from the University of Copenhagen.
