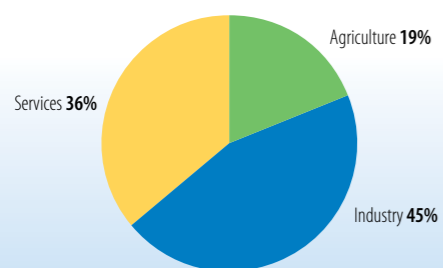

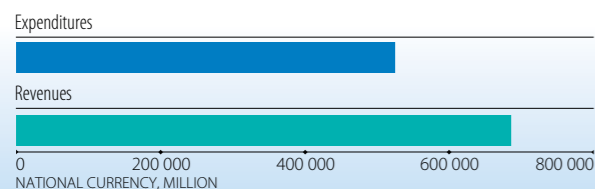

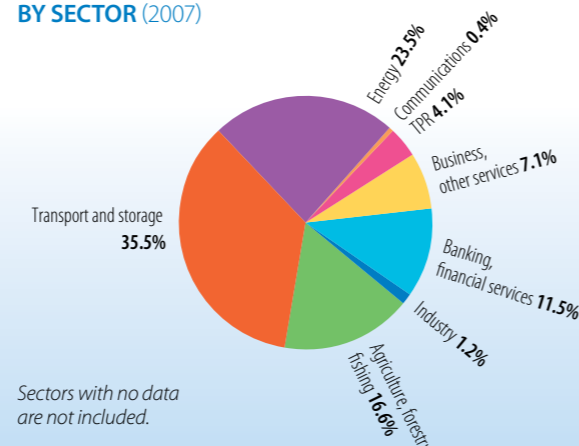

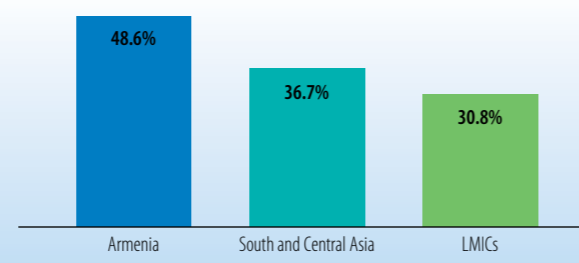
BY SECTOR (2007)

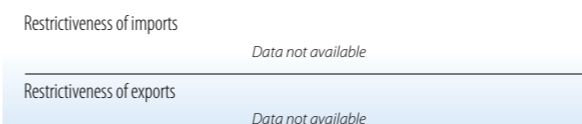

Trade is **partly** mainstreamed in the national development plan.

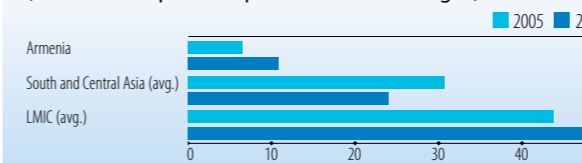

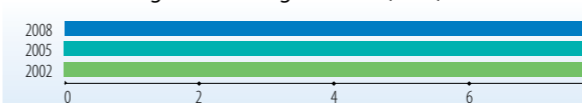
PRIORITY 1: EXPORT DIVERSIFICATION¹³

Product diversification (Number of equivalent products at SITC 3-digits)



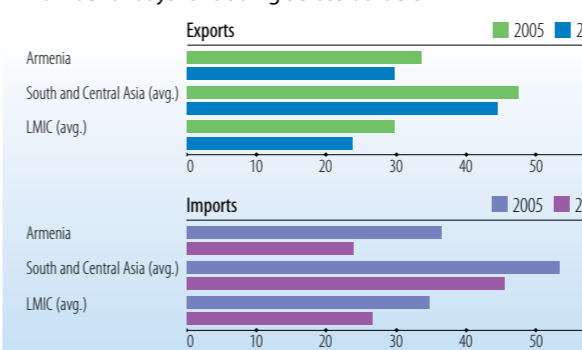
PRIORITY 2: REGIONAL INTEGRATION¹⁴

PRIORITY 3: TRADE FACILITATION¹⁵

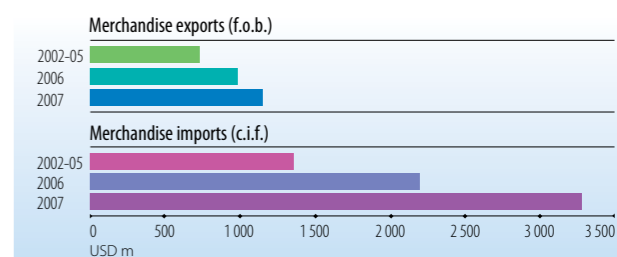
Number of days for trading across borders



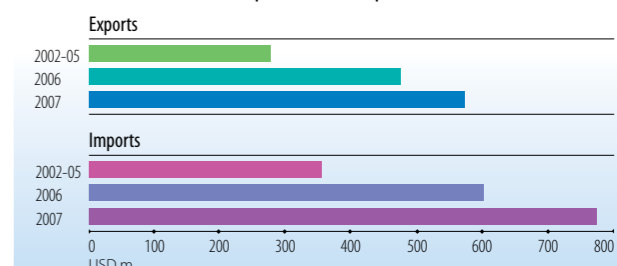

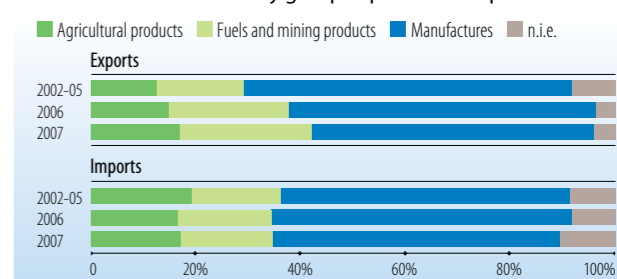
