### **ICT compendium releases**

In September 2004 the statistical office of Germany has published a comprehensive volume with statistical results from all official statistical surveys referring to ICT in its broadest sense. It starts with macro economic aspects in terms of National Accounts.

The findings for the different sectors of the economy for branches as well as for goods follow the definitions and recommendations of the OECD (with some slight modifications according to specific national aspects.) Furthermore the findings represent both the latest developments and show the changes over time (since 1995). The publication refers to the following issues:

- For Households esp. their equipment with durable ICT-goods and other electronic goods (for different household groups and the usage of ICT related goods of various user groups (according to the ICT-pilotstudy on behalf of the EC)
- ICT in firms esp. the usage (for the major branches of the economy)
- ICT related aspects of education and professional training (at schools, universities etc.)
- expenses for ICT (in Science and the public sector)
- Cyber crime
- treatment of electronic waste.

Most of the data are collected by the bodies of official statistics. Some data refer to other public institutions like "Telekom".

The publication consists of several tables and figures - in total more than 100 - which are described verbally in an introductory part for each chapter.
