Dr. Luz Maria de la Mora has served as Assistant Minister of Economic Relations and International Cooperation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. She is responsible for strengthening, extending and consolidating Mexico's economic relations and international cooperation.

Prior to her current appointment, Dr de la Mora served as Deputy Secretary of International Trade Negotiations at the Ministry of Economy where she was responsible for the negotiations and follow up on the implementation of trade agreements with Latin American, Caribbean and European countries.

Before that, in the Ministry of the Economy she served on several positions abroad: Director of the Trade Office in the Mexican Mission to the European Union in Brussels, Belgium (2003-2005); Representative of Mexico to the Latin American Integration Association (ALADI) in Montevideo, Uruguay (2002-2003); and Counselor in the Mexican Embassy in Washington DC (1997-2001) where she was in charged of promoting Mexican foreign economic relations with Europe, Latin America and North America.

Luz Maria de la Mora holds a Ph.D on Political Science from Yale University and a Masters on International Relations from the Carleton University in Ottawa, Canada. She has published several papers on economic policy, trade and investment issues.
