Supply-use tables converted using the Industry-Technology assumption.

The tables are based on 'medium' and 'large' tables provided by Statistics Canada. These tables contained a number of data omissions, reflecting disclosive data. The missing data points have been estimated using 'expert' judgement.

In doing so, differences between supply and demand were reduced to less than 0.25%, or 40 million \$, for each product, at which stage the Use table was 'RASsed' to achieve balances.

The import flow matrix has been derived using the standard import-proportion assumption, with one small divergence. 30% of exports were included in the calculation, (rather than none) as exports were greater than total domestic supply for a number of products. 30% was chosen as a prudent estimate.

Estimates for input structure (and output) of the computer services industry (IO33) use the same input structure as IO34 except for intermediate consumption of computer services. As such users are advised to re-aggregate these industries for (Leontief) analytical purposes.

The original tables did not record software as investment (SNA93), as such:

estimates for software investment have been derived assuming that 50% of all domestic intermediate consumption and 100% of imported intermediate consumption (as recorded in Can Stats' original Supply-Use tables) can be re-designated as investment under ESA95 (except intermediate consumption by the computer services and wholesale/retail industries). This leads to an increase in GDP of 5.5 billion C\$. No estimates have been included for own-account production.

Intermediate consumption by Dummy industries (148-154 in the Canadian tables (see concordance) has been allocated to purchasing industries on a pro-rata basis (proportional to consumption of dummy industry output).
