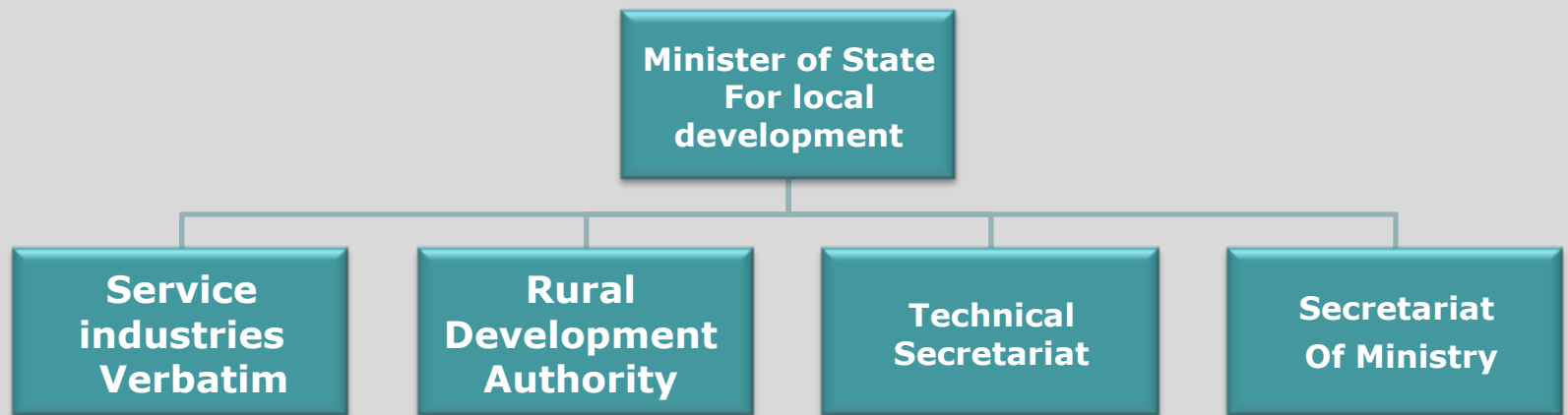

Ministry of State for Local Development



Unit Establishment

- The Minister issued a decree to establish a special unit and defined its task to collect all the legislative tools that influence business and investment climate
- The decree was communicated to the different authorities in the Ministry in order :
 - Coordinate with the Unit to ensure the providing of the requested legislations.
 - Create channels between the unit and all the ministerial departments of legal devices.

Scope of Inventory

Remarks

1. The large number of laws related to local development in many areas, especially those related to the central ministries
2. The magnitude of the decisions and decrees of the Board of Governors
3. Overlap and duplication between the legislative tools for local development and the rest of the other sectors
4. The need for ongoing coordination between the Cabinet, Ministry of Local Development and some other ministerial units, which has direct and indirect local development.

Decrees of the Board of Governors

Proposed Solutions for the problem of magnitude of the decisions and decrees of the Board of Governors

- Three provinces are selected to specified standards and an initial inventory and review of the decisions of these provincial Governors
- This project is expected to take six months. After assessing the experience, the possibility of implementation in the remaining governorates will take place , respectively.
