The use of Country system lagging behind. Confirmed by Accra Regional Consultations and Paris survey data. More ambitions is needed

Big What : reinforce use of Country Systems

Why: only way to have ownership, best way to strengthen local capacity

At the level of country systems : ownership

Engage in the development of workable vision, clarify options, eg for PFM get out of the of “an array of confused options”, be aware of dangers of TA own perspectives,

Develop plans , these plans need to be “focused” but with attention to linkages and as much as possible holistic - PFM

Political vision and consensus / Political decisions on how to improve system is a starting point

Work on broad national engagement – necessary for transparent and credible plans in the area of procurement

Realistic need assessment , getting good data is a challenge

Agreed targets and monitoring/ baseline

Flexible MT/LT plan , focusing on benefits of CD action. Need to be understandable, including to buy support from high level national leaders (competition for scarce resources)

Managing aid and related partnership issues

Use of CS should be the default option. If CS are not used, reasons should be compelling and discussed in open dialogue, gaps identified and addressed.

Country based initiative on CD for strengthening national systems, country led, championed at HL

Stop the erosion of local systems by use of parallel mechanisms

Change practices of TC, reshape TA and its role, really make it demand driven

Improve predictability – link aid with budget cycle, LT engagement. funding mechanisms should be aligned to M-L term CD plans

Make smart “local tailored” use of South South exchange (fit the context), use of Diaspora to reinforce systems

Donors stop isolated pet initiative, dialogue – agreement on new CD initiative

Be aware of danger of vertical fund
