

## **Slavomir Stastny, Member of the Bank Board, the National Bank of Slovakia**

Since January 2006 is he the Member of the Board of the National Bank of Slovakia – the Slovak central bank and single financial market supervisory authority. In the bank management is he responsible for financial education and information technologies. He represents the bank in IOSCO and CEIOPS. He is also delegate of the Slovak Republic to the Committee on Financial Markets of OECD.

Before joining the central bank he was nominated for two consecutive terms as the Board member and the vice-chair of the Slovak Financial Market Authority (the former supervisory body in the area of capital markets, insurance and pensions) with addressed responsibility for the capital market supervision. In the late 90s he was appointed Director of the Agency of State Supervision Over the Capital Market in the Slovak Republic. In the Slovak financial market is he active since 1992.

He is graduated from the Czech Technical University in Prague, post-graduated from the Slovak Technical University in Bratislava and awarded MBA degree from Rochester Institute of Technology, Rochester, N.Y.
