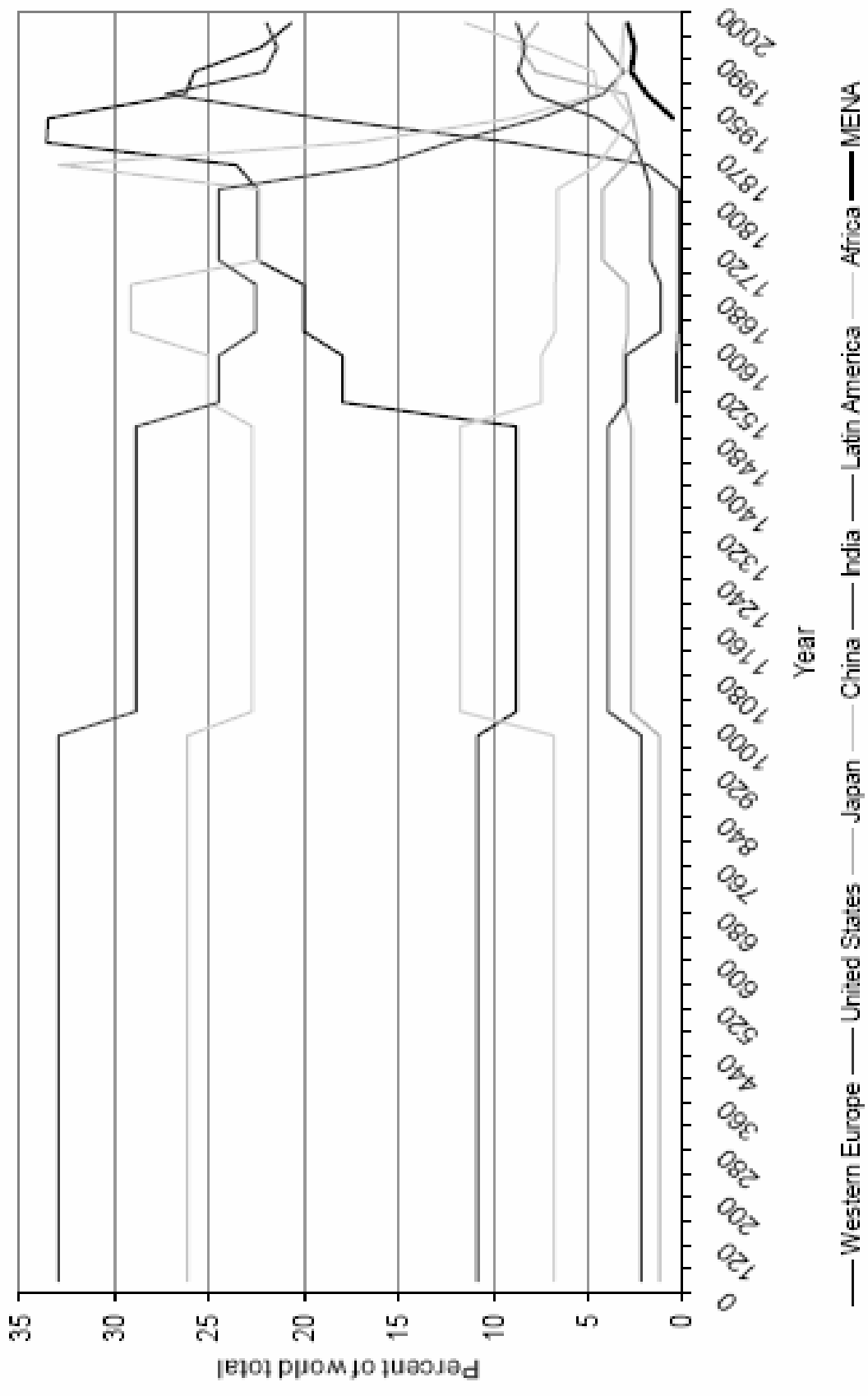

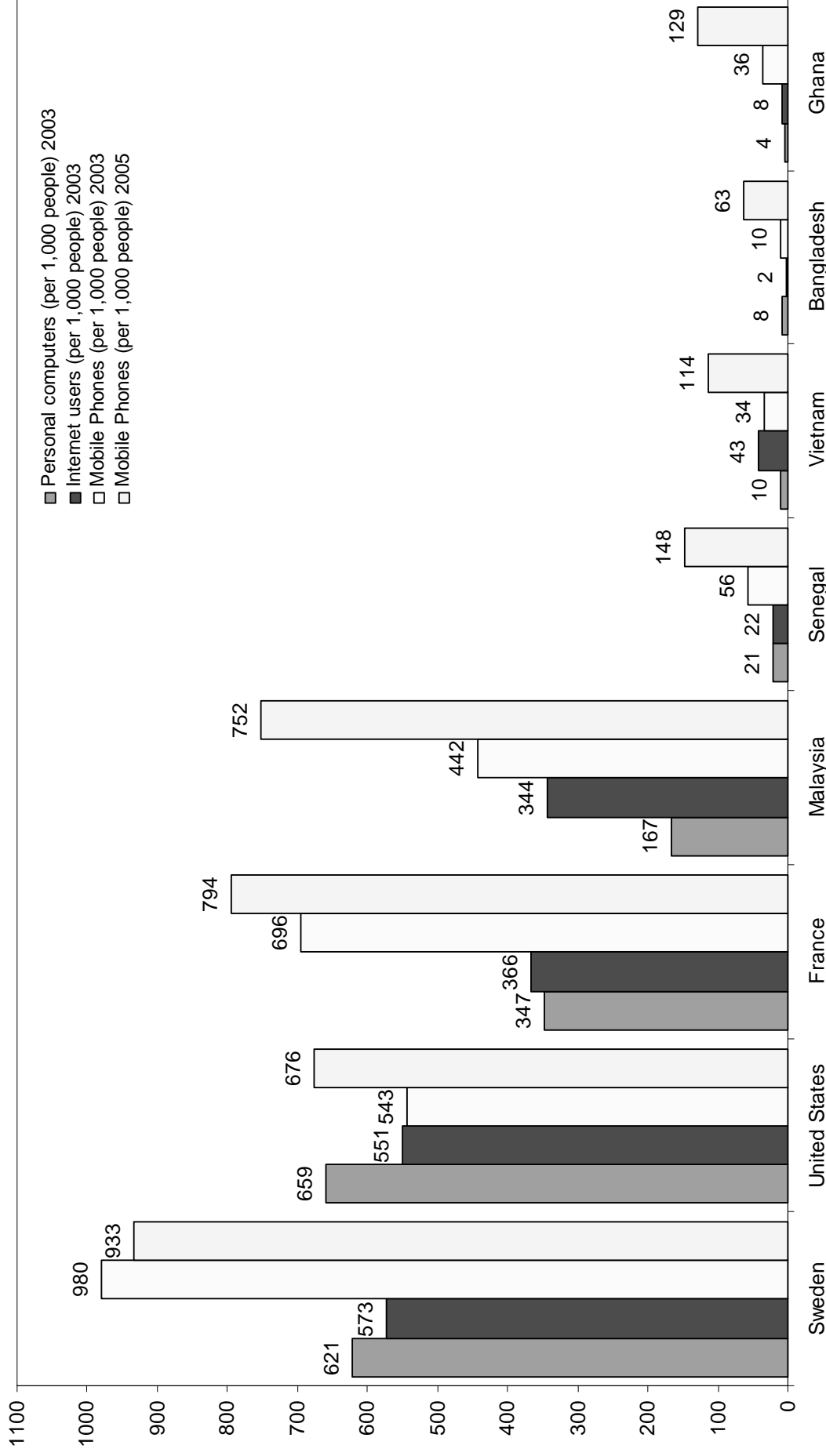


Shares of World GDP, 0-2000 A.D.
