Investment in environment is necessary for improving economic, social and political conditions in developing countries within the framework of sustainable development.

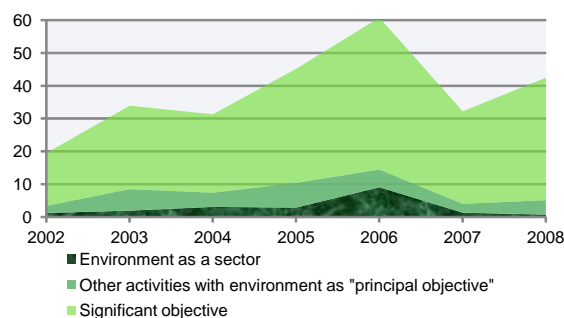
An activity can target environment as a "principal objective" or "significant objective". Principal means environment was an explicit objective of the activity and fundamental in its design. Significant means environment was an important, but secondary, objective of the activity. Not targeted means that the activity was screened for promoting environment, but was not found to have targeted it.

All activities have been screened against the environment marker: the environment coverage ratio is thus 100%.

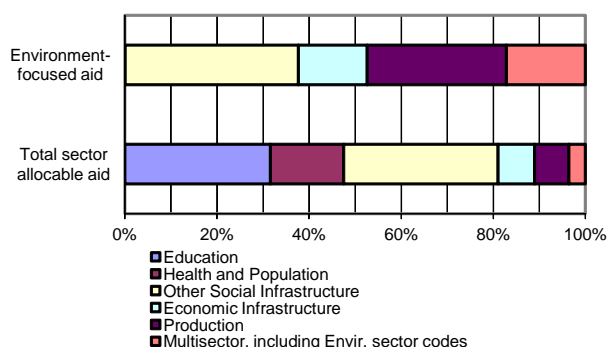

Total environment-focused aid, 2007 USD million

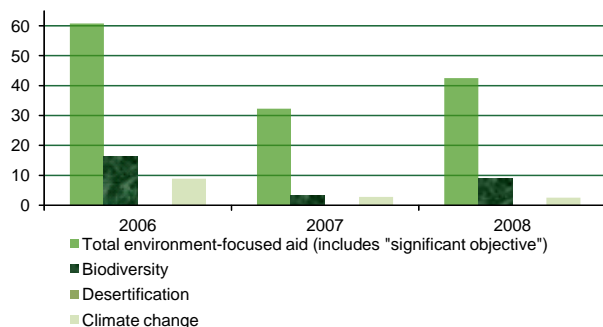
