Sampling method	The MTIC 2004 was raised as an attached certificate of the ESIDET 2004, so they share the design sample characteristics. In other words, there is not a specific design for the module. There was taking a sample by sector and by activity under the following scheme: Mining: Simple random sampling. Manufacturing: (it excludes the export assembly plants): Random sampling stratified by branch of activity according to the classification of OECD. Construction: The sample forms with the 50 more important companies according to the variable of income. Electricity: The sample includes the producers of the public sector.

	<p>Services: Random sampling stratified by branch of activity in agreement with OECD classification.</p> <p>Commerce: The sample is integrated by the 120 companies of greater participation in the occupied variable of personnel; this group of companies, responded MTIC 2004 solely.</p> <p>Superior Education and non-Lucrative Private Institutions and Government: The sample forms with the total of institutions that make activities of the IDT in agreement with the directories of the CONACYT.</p>
