International Launch of PISA 2009 Report TRENDS IN PERFORMANCE SINCE 2000

The Organisation of Economic Development and Co-operation (OECD) together with the Polish Government and the Educational Research Institute (IBE) are organising the international launch of the Volume V of the PISA 2009 International Report on “Learning Trends: Changes in Student Performance Since 2000”.
