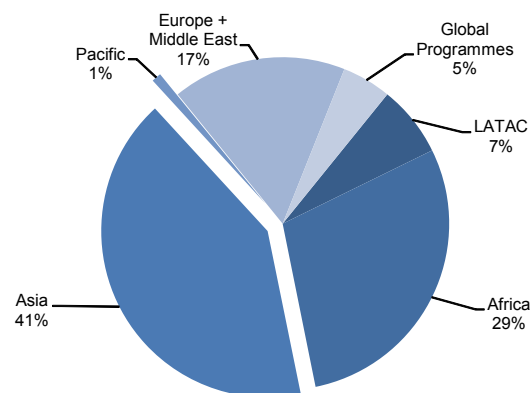

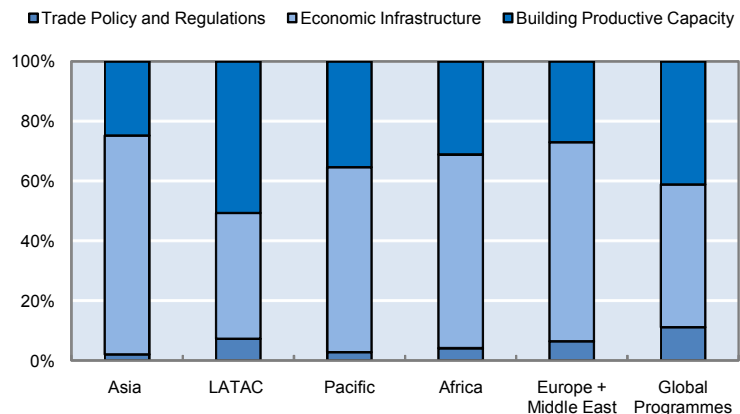
Geographical Distribution of Aid for Trade
