

## Mr. Andrzej Kwiecinski – brief note



ANDRZEJ KWIECINSKI joined the OECD in 1995. Currently he is a Senior Agricultural Policy Analyst in the Development Division of the OECD's Trade and Agriculture Directorate. He has worked extensively on a large number of countries including China, Russia, Ukraine, India, Poland, Estonia, Romania and most recently Israel. He has been the main author and a leader of teams preparing OECD reviews of agricultural policies in several transition economies with the special focus on structural reforms, support policies and the calculation of the level of support. His most recent work on China includes an assessment of rural profile for the OECD review of rural development published in 2009 and a comprehensive review of agricultural policies published in 2005.

Prior to joining the OECD, Dr. Kwiecinski was associate professor at the Department of Economics of Warsaw University and was contributing to the work of various research and advisory bodies advising on Poland's agricultural policy reform and aiming at Poland's accession to the European Union.

Mr. Kwiecinski has a PhD in economics from Warsaw University.

Mr. Kwiecinski is fluent in Polish, English, French and Russian.
