

Giovanna Nicodano is professor of financial economics at the University of Torino, where she is serving as chair of the Masters Programmes in Economics, Finance and Insurance.

She is research fellow at “CeRP-Collegio Carlo Alberto”, at the “Network for Studies on Pensions, Aging and Retirement” and was recently nominated research associate of the “European Corporate Governance Institute”. Her research deals with corporate finance, strategic asset allocation and incomplete capital markets. It has been published in the *Journal of Finance*, the *Journal of Banking and Finance*, the *Journal of Real Estate Finance and Economics*, the *Review of Finance* as well as in leading economics journals such as the *European Economic Review*, the *Journal of Public Economics* and *Real Estate Economics*.

A recipient of the European Investment Bank Prize, she obtained her Ph.D. in 1990 from Princeton University. She began her career as assistant professor at Università Bocconi. In Torino she co-founded the Centre for Research on Pension (CeRP) in 1999, and initiated then the research project on “Asset Classes for Long Run Investors”.

She has been a visiting scholar at CEMFI Madrid, the London School of Economics and the Universities of Amsterdam, Haifa and Freiburg. She has been involved, also as national coordinator, in projects sponsored by the EU Commission and the European Science Foundation.
