Mr. Kelly served as a consultant for the World Bank, UNDP, UNICEF, USAID, IDB, JICA and international NGOs in Sub-Saharan Africa, South Asia, and the former Soviet Union. Before beginning his work as an economic advisor, Mr. Kelly was a Fulbright Scholar in Kenya, and a Professor of Economics at universities in the United States and Mexico. His scholarly research and technical publications have focused on poverty reduction, governance, and education in developing countries.
