

Curriculum Vitae – Jérôme Saulnier

Jérôme Saulnier holds a PhD in Applied Economics (highest distinction) from the University of Grenoble in France, where he has been an assistant professor from 2000 to 2003. He has also worked as a research associate in the University of California at Berkeley. Since May 2003, he is employed as an economic analyst by the Economic and Financial Affairs Directorate of the European Commission in Brussels, where he has been involved in the evaluation of reforms in the areas of product markets and innovation. In particular, he has worked extensively on the development of an evidence based approach towards the assessment of structural reforms (the Lisbon Assessment Framework).
