Examine members' contributions to advance gender equality and women's empowerment in key economic sectors.

➤ **Social sectors: education & health**

Assess members' contributions and identify possible changes in members' aid allocations since last report.

State-of-play of members’ reporting on the gender equality policy marker in the field of humanitarian assistance; possible identification of trends.

Report on gender equality focused aid – topics for analysis

➤ **Special focus: fragility and conflict**

Produce statistics on gender equality specific funding for conflict-affected states and countries in situations of fragility.

In addition to bilateral contributions identified through the gender equality marker, take into account, to the extent possible, members' contributions to multilateral institutions
