

Vangelis Vitalis, Deputy Director and Senior Negotiator, Trade Negotiations Division, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade

Vangelis has worked at the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), the New Zealand Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (MFAT) and as a consultant. At the OECD he has worked on a range of issues including investment (during the MAI negotiations) and more recently on sustainable development (2001-2004). With MFAT he was posted to the New Zealand Embassy in Moscow. Subsequently, he worked as a technical adviser/consultant on issues like currency reform and WTO accession in Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan and at the Russian Ministry of Agriculture. Vangelis was also a member of the International Economics Expert Working Group which advised the Ministerial Task Force on IUU Fishing from 2004-06. Currently, Vangelis works as a New Zealand trade negotiator covering a range of WTO-related issues (rules, environment and development) and is the lead negotiator on investment, environment and labour in all of New Zealand's ongoing FTA negotiations, including with China, ASEAN countries, the Gulf Cooperation Council and Malaysia.
