David A. Rust is the Deputy Commissioner for Retirement and Disability Policy of the Social Security Administration. As the Deputy Commissioner, he directs and manages the planning, development and issuance of operational policy and instructions for the Retirement, Survivors and Disability Insurance (RSDI) and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) programs and initiatives as well as programs to promote the employment of beneficiaries with disabilities. In addition, he is the principal advisor to the Commissioner of Social Security on major policy issues and activities in the areas of strategic policy planning, policy research and evaluation, statistical programs and overall policy development and analysis.

Mr. Rust has held high-level positions in several branches of the Federal government having previously served in the Departments of Health and Human Services and Agriculture, and as a Legislative staffer with the U.S. Senate. He previously served as the Associate Commissioner for Disability and Special Assistant to the Commissioner of Social Security. His most recent position before returning to the Social Security Administration was with the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

Mr. Rust holds a B.S. Degree from Frostburg State University and has done graduate work at Towson University and The American University.
