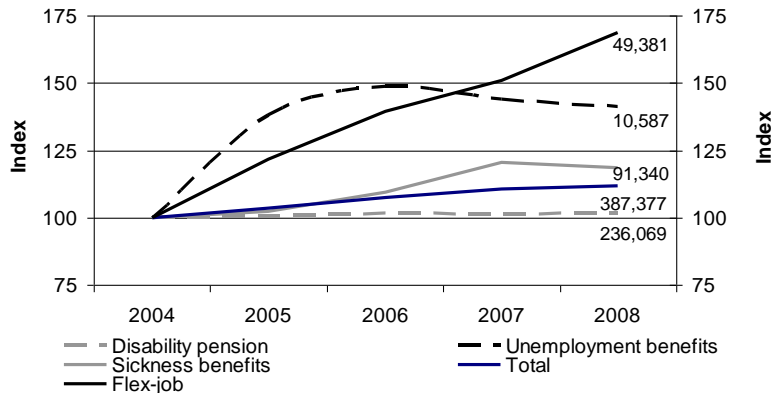


Unemployed persons receiving permanent benefits

Summary

- The flex-job scheme has been far more successful than expected.
- The flex-job scheme is a “win-win situation” for the parties involved; the employee, the employer *and* trade unions.
- Unfortunately, the flex-jobs scheme has not reduced the number of people granted disability pensions.
- There might be people in the flex-job scheme, who could cope with a job on normal terms, if they had been rehabilitated.
- We are considering whether there is a need for further changes in the flex-job scheme that would limit access to flex-jobs for people who are able to cope with a job on normal terms.
