Foreword

This CD ROM contains data corresponding to those published in the publication on statistics of international trade in services produced by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) in cooperation with the Statistical Office of the European Communities (Eurostat). It reflects the efforts made over the past decade to elaborate classifications to reflect changes in the nature of service products traded, to provide extra detail needed by analysts and trade policy specialists, to increase consistency between different international statistical systems, to harmonise data collection procedures and improve comparability as well as to reduce the response burden placed upon reporting countries.

Its aim is to assemble and disseminate balance of payments data at the most detailed level available on transactions of services between residents of the reporting country and non-residents.

The OECD Secretariat and Eurostat are very grateful to member country experts who have kindly provided much information and many comments during the preparatory phase of this publication.

1. Introduction

This publication of OECD in cooperation with Eurostat seeks to provide detailed data of international trade in services between residents and non-residents of the 30 OECD Member countries broken down by type of service according to a common classification and conceptual framework.

The types of service are presented according to the services classification of the 1993 Fifth Edition of the Balance of Payments Manual of the International Monetary Fund (BPM5) and its detailed extension, the Extended Balance of Payments Services¹ (EBOPS) Classification (given in Appendix 1). The EBOPS classification is closely linked to the BPM5. EBOPS can be characterised as a disaggregation of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) classification for balance of payments transactions in trade in services. The main categories of this classification are identical to the 11 main service categories of the BPM5 standard components, with one minor exception, the treatment of construction services, which can also affect other business services. The EBOPS classification asks for *construction abroad* and *construction in the compiling economy*. These items both include goods and services purchased by construction services operations, while BPM5 recommends that these expenditures for goods and services purchased in the host economy be included in *Other business services, Other*. With this one exception, compiling and reporting on the basis of the EBOPS classification simultaneously satisfies IMF requirements.

The EBOPS classification is designed to address some of the detailed information needs of the General Agreement on Trade in Services (GATS). As yet, countries are not in a position to provide all the detailed data required in the EBOPS classification. It can be expected that the resulting missing data may over time be reduced.

Data are available in format Beyond 20/20 (see part 2). The CD ROM contains the file Notes.pdf containing definitions of the series, as well as CanNotes-e.pdf that contains detailed Canadian notes.

The *Beyond 20/20* data browser is also provided on the CD ROM with installation instructions.

This guide presents a summary of the organisation and contents of the OECD Statistics on International Trade in Services CD ROM.

2. Description of *Trade in Services on Beyond 20/20*

A separate manual is provided for technical assistance.

The data in the *Beyond 20/20* software are presented in a 6-dimensional table. The six dimensions of the table are countries, currencies (millions of United States dollars, national currency, Millions of euros- *i.e.* national currency for EU members and Millions of euros (ECU)¹), items of the Extended Balance of Payments Services (EBOPS) Classification, flows (Expressions), the time period and the partners (world, Extra EU 15, Extra EU 25, Extra euro area).

On opening the tables, the series and flows for each country and each currency are presented vertically with time shown across the page. The table may be changed easily for different presentations. The electronic version of the publication contains data from 1970 to 2005 for those countries for which data are available.

3. Installation procedure of *Trade in Services on Beyond 20/20*

Installing *Beyond 20/20* and the OECD Statistics on International Trade in Services CD ROM on your hard disk.

1. Insert the CD ROM into your CD ROM drive;
2. In File manager (*WindowsTM 3.1*) or *WindowsTM Explorer* (*WindowsTM 95* or higher, or *WindowsTM NT*), click on drive d: (if your CD ROM drive is not drive d:, then replace d: with the appropriate letter) and then double click on SETUP.BAT file (16 or 32 bits versions);
3. Follow the instructions.

Please note that the CD ROM also includes the files Notes.pdf (containing definitions of the series), CanNotes-e.pdf (containing detailed Canadian notes and definitions).

¹ The Units millions of euros and millions of euros (ecus) present the same data up to 1999.

4. Trade in Services on Beyond 20/20 Compared with the Paper Publication

The *OECD Statistics on International Trade in Services, Detailed Tables by Service Category* CD ROM contains all the series available in the paper publication, as well as extra-EU trade data, i.e. excluding intra European Union trade, for European countries who have provided the data. This set of data is provided after the zone totals (“country name – extra-EU”). Data are also provided for the European Union Institutions.

While the paper publication shows data from 1997-2005, the electronic version covers data from 1970 to 2005 for the countries for which this data is available.

Like the paper version, the *OECD Statistics on International Trade in Services* CD ROM contains individual country notes and a description of the coverage of the series. These are in the file Notes.pdf.

5. Contents of the CD ROM

General Note

Data are submitted directly to the OECD by the non-EU OECD Member countries and are published without any further changes. Data for the nineteen European Union (EU) countries that are also members of the OECD are transmitted to the OECD by Eurostat. The data are submitted directly to Eurostat by the EU countries and in some cases have been adjusted - corrected or estimated - by Eurostat in order to enable the calculation of EU totals. A table showing the items which Eurostat estimates for the EU countries in 2005 is given in Appendix 4. Data adjusted by Eurostat are only published in the Country Tables if they have been explicitly approved by the country concerned. This work sharing procedure ensures that data shown in the present publication and those published by Eurostat in their publications on international trade in services are the same. This feature addresses users' requirements for data consistency. To the same effect, comparable zone totals for the EU, the OECD, the North America Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), the OECD – Asia and Pacific, the OECD – Europe and the Major seven (G7: Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, United Kingdom, United States) countries are published in a single volume (for definitions of geographical zones, please refer to Appendix 3). Additional national classification detail for some non-EU countries are available in file TIS EXTRA.ivt.

Data are provided from 1970 to 2005 as available in the Beyond 20/20 file TIS.ivt. For the non-EU OECD countries, the backdating of series to conform to BPM5 norms, is done by the countries themselves. For the EU Member countries still using the BPM4 methodology, data are converted by Eurostat to BPM5.

The coding system is that agreed upon by the IMF, OECD and Eurostat for standard components, subcomponents and memorandum items of the BPM5 classification of services and the Extended Balance of Payments Services (EBOPS) Classification (see Appendix 1). Nevertheless, three items have been added to these classifications:

- *Other services, total*, code 981, showing the magnitude of services other than *Transportation and Travel*;
- *Commercial services*, code 983, showing the magnitude of services other than *Government services n.i.e.*; and
- *Services not allocated*, code 982, provided by Eurostat, as a balancing item for services which EU countries have not been able to allocate to items of the classification.

For analytical purposes, the tables also include certain non-service items: total trade in goods, total trade in goods and services, income, current transfers, total current account, capital account and financial account, and net errors and omissions. These other items shown in the standard country tables are listed in Appendix 2.

Countries are requested to submit data at the most detailed level possible according to the EBOPS classification.

The exchange rate used for conversion from national currency to U.S. dollars (see Notes.doc), when data is reported by countries in their national unit of account, is given in the Beyond 20/20 file TIS.ivt. It corresponds to the annual averages of market exchange rates and official exchange rates for countries quoting rates in units of national currency per USD. The exchange rates are taken from the IMF *International Financial Statistics* database. Users should note that since February 2002 the national exchange rates for the euro area countries have been converted into euro (see below for more information).

US dollar exchange rates used for the conversion of national data into US dollars are shown without decimals in series named "IMF NAT/USD exchange rates". They can be viewed in the dataset for each country by choosing the unit "national currency", the expression "net", the partner "world" and the country name. Decimal places can be shown by clicking on View, Decimals.

NB. In accordance with the presentation adopted in the paper publication, **all debit data are shown as positive**. Only net data are shown as negative, if appropriate.

Rounding

Figures have been rounded in the tables. There may therefore be rounding differences between an aggregate and the sum of its components or slight differences between net data and the difference between the credit and debit figures shown.

USD exchange rates for euro area countries

The option chosen by OECD is to convert exchange rates for periods prior to entry into European Monetary Union (i.e. prior to 1999 for all members apart from Greece, which acceded in 2001) from the former national currency exchange rate using the appropriate euro irrevocable conversion rate.

Such a conversion facilitates comparisons over time within a country and also preserves the historical evolution (i.e. growth rates). This conversion does not change the USD values.

For further details, see *Statistics Brief*, Number 2, February 2002 (www.oecd.org/statistics, choose Statistics Brief).

For presentational purposes, and to distinguish the resulting euro denomination of the national currency from a true conversion into an international currency, OECD uses the label: '[year of accession] [ISO currency code] euro' e.g.: **1999 FRF euro**.

5.1 The Countries

The OECD Member countries are:

Australia, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Korea, Luxembourg, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovak Republic, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, United Kingdom and United States.

Note that:

- for EU countries extra-EU trade (i.e. excluding intra-EU trade) figures are shown;
- EU 15 and EU 25 totals (EU – total and EU – extra-EU) are presented. These data cannot be derived from the individual country tables due to missing data for some countries. They are obtained by estimating unpublished national data (see Appendix 4 for the list of items estimated by Eurostat). Data for EU totals refer to EU12 until 1991 and to EU15 from 1992;
- Euro area totals for extra-euro area trade (i.e. excluding intra euro area trade) are also presented;
- Data for the European Union Institutions are provided.

Country and zone codes are given in Appendix 3.

5.2 Data Availability by Country

Table 1 below shows the availability of the main items of the EBOPS classification. Certain items and sub-items may start at a later date than that shown.
