

VESSELIN VALCHEV, M.Sc.

Mr. Vesselin Valchev was born on 3 May 1954 in Sofia, Bulgaria. He attended the Bruno Leuschner University in Berlin, Germany and the University of World and National Economy in Sofia, Bulgaria. He graduated from the latter with a M.Sc. degree in International Economic Relations in 1979.

Mr. Valchev specialized extensively in the fields of economics and politics in Vienna, Moscow and Chicago. He has earned a Certificate for Trading with Futures and Options from De Paul University and the Chicago Mercantile Exchange Programme (1994). He has been elected for a number of years as vice-president of the International Union of Students (IUS) in Prague, Czech Republic. During the period 1995 – 1997 he was a Minister in the Bulgarian government.

Mr. Vesselin Valchev has lectured as a guest speaker at a number of international events in Europe, North America, Asia, and Africa. In 2001 and 2002 he was an OSCE supervisor to the Kosovo parliamentary and local elections. Currently, he is a Councillor to the President of Bulgaria.

Mr. Valchev is a Member of the Managing Board of the Bulgarian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (www.bcci.bg). In this capacity, he has participated in a number of national and international economic fora. He is registered Consultant with the Central Consultancy Register (CCR) of DG 1A of the European Commission in Brussels. Mr. Valchev is a Member of the Board of Trustees of ING PF, board member of the Bulgarian – American Trade and Economic Council and the Working Group on economic cooperation with the Central Federal Region of Russia. Since 1997 he is a Managing partner of IMCA Associates – a Bulgarian private consultancy company (www.imca-bg.com). Mr. Valchev consults foreign companies about Bulgarian legislation, political risks, capital markets, and privatization opportunities, prepares companies profiles, economic analyses, market research, market-entry strategies, mergers and acquisitions and assists in privatization projects and the establishment of joint ventures with Bulgarian companies, as well as representation of foreign companies before the Bulgarian authorities.
