Charalampos Tsarouchas was appointed Secretary General of the Black Sea Trade and Development bank in January 2001. In January 2004 he was re-appointed at the same post for another three-year term.

He started his banking carrier at the Ionian Bank of Greece, where he held progressively responsible positions during the period of 1985 - 1998, established the bank's branch in Bulgaria and became its General Manager in 1994.

Having acquired solid professional experience in the Balkan and Black Sea region, he was appointed Managing Director of the Interbalkan and Black Sea Business Center (DIPEK) in Thessaloniki, Greece in 1997.

In 1999 he became Managing Director of Thessaloniki International Fair, where he served until his appointment to the Black Sea Trade and Development Bank.

Charalampos Tsarouchas holds a degree from the Economic School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece, and an MBA from the University of Lincolnshire and Humberside, UK.
