Pierre Daurès, born in May 1940, a graduate in civil engineering and atomic engineering, has spent his whole career at Electricité de France (EDF) since 1966: first at the Engineering Division, then in the department for General Economic Studies.

Manager of Bugey nuclear power station, then of the staff and labour relations division of EDF-GDF, in 1987 he was appointed Vice President Director of EDG-GDF Services, which then numbered 30 million customers for gas and electricity.

Deputy Managing Director for nuclear and industrial issues, then Chief Operating Officer (COO) in 1994, Pierre Daurès became Chief Executive Officer of EDF in 1996.

On 1 March 1999, Pierre Daurès joined the Bouygues Group as Executive Vice President.

Vice-chair 2003, Chairman 2004 and past-President and Member of the Board 2005 for Business Advisory council for South Eastern Europe.
