Dr Krassen Stanchev (e-mail: stanchev@ime.bg) is the Executive Director of the Institute for Market Economics (since 1993) (website: www.ime-bg.org), former member of parliament, one of the most quoted Bulgarian observers, best individual country analyst award for 1996 by Euromoney and a nominee for Bulgaria's Mr. Ekonomika 2004. He was, in 1995, an initiator of the Balkan Network and the European Emerging Economies Network, and has a rich experience in the region (Bosnia and Herzegovina, Macedonia, and Serbia and Montenegro), Central Europe and the FSU.

Mr. Stanchev is a former member of parliament (1990-1991 Constitutional, head of the environment committee. He promoted IME, the first Bulgaria's independent economic think tank, as one of the most respected public policy institute in the emerging European democracies. The area of his personal expertise is key economic and regulatory policies are as follows: cost-benefit analysis of regulations, business environment and administrative barriers, competitiveness, law making (environment policy act, mortgage bonds, special purpose investment vehicles, business registration, etc.) and think tank management.
