

How to use the Pivot Table: 2006 Survey on Monitoring the Paris Declaration Full Data Set

The Pivot Table allows users to extract data that was used for the 2006 Survey on Monitoring the Paris Declaration. Users are able to organize the pivot table either by Donors (54 donors), Recipients (34 countries), or Indicators 3, 4, 5a, 5b, 6, 7, 9, 10a and 10b.

Options for selecting Donors, Recipients and Indicators are found below.

For example, you would like to see the data for Canada:

1. Drag and Drop "Canada" into the Report Filter Box
2. Drag and Drop "Recipients" into the Row Labels
3. Drag and drop Indicators you are interested. For example, if you are interested in seeing Canada's data for Indicator 3, select the corresponding categories from Table 2 (find below), Sum of Donor Q1 and Sum of Donor Q2 in to the "values" box.
4. A table will automatically be generated for you.
