Ms. Fulponi is an economist in the Agricultural trade and markets division of the Trade and Agriculture Directorate where she has worked for over 25 years. She has contributed to the directorate's quantitative analysis of markets and trade over this period. In the recent period her work has focussed on issues related to food, from biotechnology and food standards to food prices and financial market impacts on the food chain.
