In the last 20 years there have been increasing demand for higher education in Egypt

# 1- Data of Egyptian Universities

---

The pressure of increase the demands on higher education open the door for private universities in Egypt

In 1982 the AUC was the only private university and in 2006 there are 12 working private universities in addition to new 5 got the license and will begin working in 2007/2008



## 2-Student Mobility

---

In the last year the number of international students in Public Universities was 9906 students in addition to about 12000 students in Al Azhar Universities and at least 20000 in Private Universities
