# Data boxes and basic registers of public administration in the Czech Republic

- It will simplify the electronic communication with the public administration for the citizens, for the businesses and between the state/public administration bodies too
- The state/public authorities will have the obligation ( defined by the law) to communicate through the data boxes with each other and also with the corporate bodies
- The delivery of the documents to the Data boxes is guaranteed by information system and will be obligatory by all bodies of the state administration including no-profit organisations, corporate bodies, commercial businesses



# Legislation on Data boxes

Act No.300/2008 Coll. on electronic transactions and the authorized conversion of the documents – we call it **eGovernment Act**

Force of the legislation: as from 1 st July 2009

It governs the functioning of Data boxes and the conversion of the documents between the electronic and the paper form.

Equalization of the paper and the electronic form of the document.

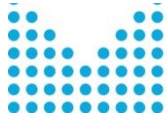
It gives the possibility to citizens to create the data boxes which enables them to easier communicate with public administration.



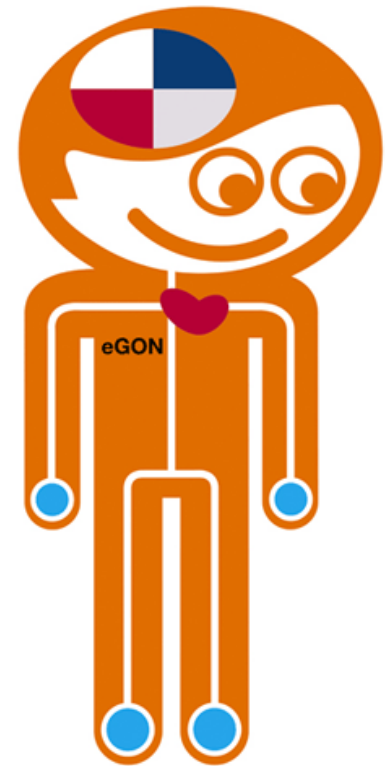
Register of inhabitants, Register of Persons (all entities with legal personality), Register of Territorial Identification, Addresses and Real Estate Property, Register of Rights and Duties

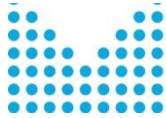
To ensure the **reliable source** of data most frequently used in the public administration

- To enable effective use of the and sharing of data which already exist in the public administration
- To reduce the necessity to ask citizens frequently on the same data
- To speed up the administration processes
- **To save time and money**



- European citizen card – European Commission agreed the technical specifications on electronic identity card ( in 2003)
- Electronic identity card enables:
  - To check the identity of the citizen
  - Function of the travel document in European Union
  - The possibility of the citizen´s communication with the state/public administration





# E – cards in Czech Republic

- **We will suppose to start to issue eCards as from 1st January 2010**
- It will look like bank credit card ( ID 1 format)

\_ E - Identity card will be protected by **the personal security code**

( it proves justice of an electronic communication of the holder during the communication with information systems of public administration)

Personal security code – combination of minimum 4 and maximum 10 digits

After the 3rd wrong (mistaken) setting : the possibility of electronic communication is automatically blocked

(Citizen then have to ask for unblocking at the appropriate municipal office)

E - identity cards will be equipped with microchip, in which a qualified certificate for the electronic signature may be placed on
