






## What coherence from the view point of processes

## **Maintaining coherence in policy processes: an example**

- The Mali Agricultural Act ( LOA) formulation process
- The first three stages are coherent at the national level
- Will the last two be coherent

## **What coherence in the contents?**

- Trade policies
  - Economic partnerships Agreement
  - ECOWAS Common External Tariff
  - Non-Tariff Barriers, public and private standards
- Development
  - Promoting investments in traditional and non-traditional export industries

## **Examples of initiatives reflecting coherence in the contents of policies**

- Cotton Farmers' Movement in favour of their industry and negotiatory positions adopted by their country
- The fouta Djalon Farmers' Movement in favour of the potato Industry in Guinea: proven economic and social outputs and relevance of investments made
- Farmers' Movement in Sénégal and its contribution to decisions on the agricultural policy( current example: the land plicy under review)
