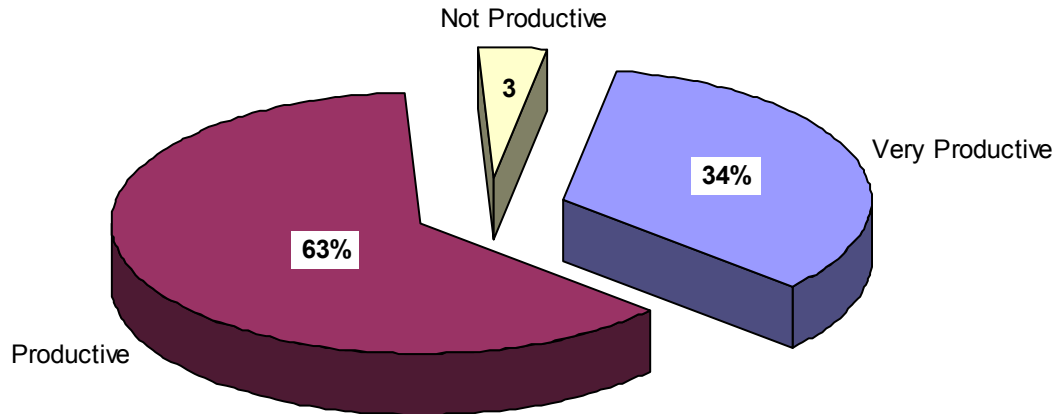


RESULTS OF EVALUATION QUESTIONNAIRE

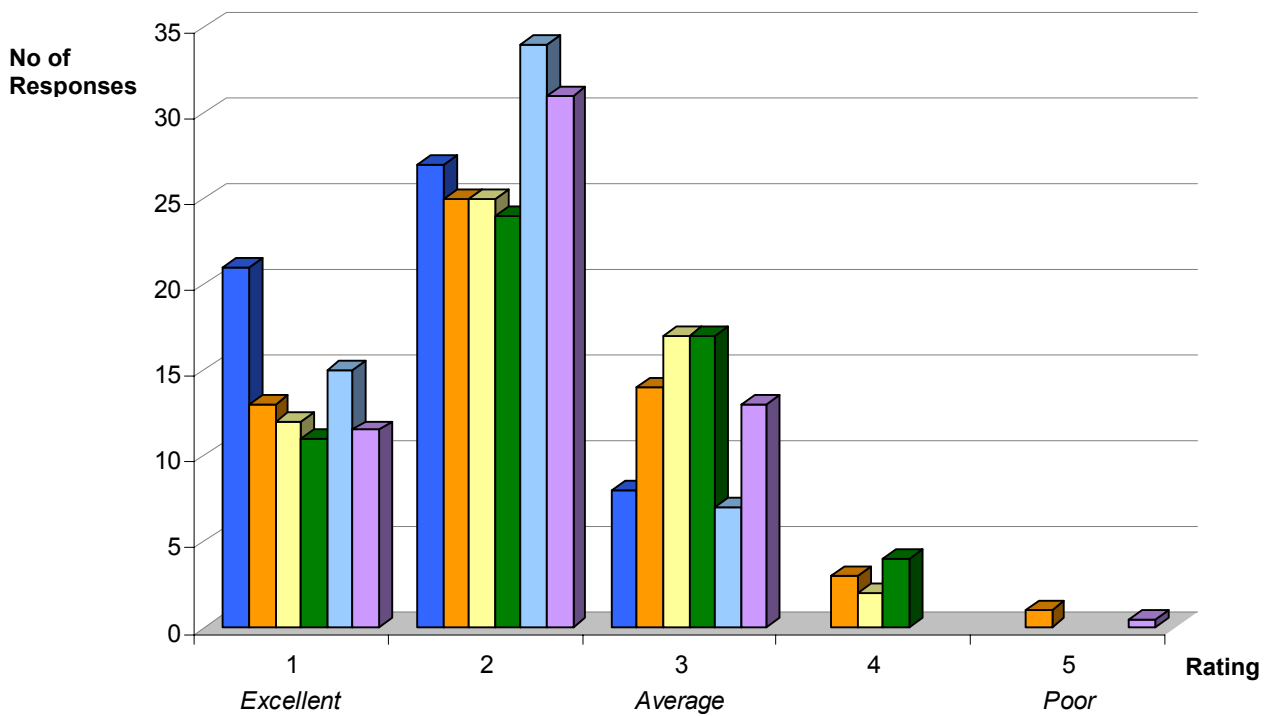
I. OVERALL IMPRESSION

II. RELEVANCE, AGENDA AND DISCUSSIONS

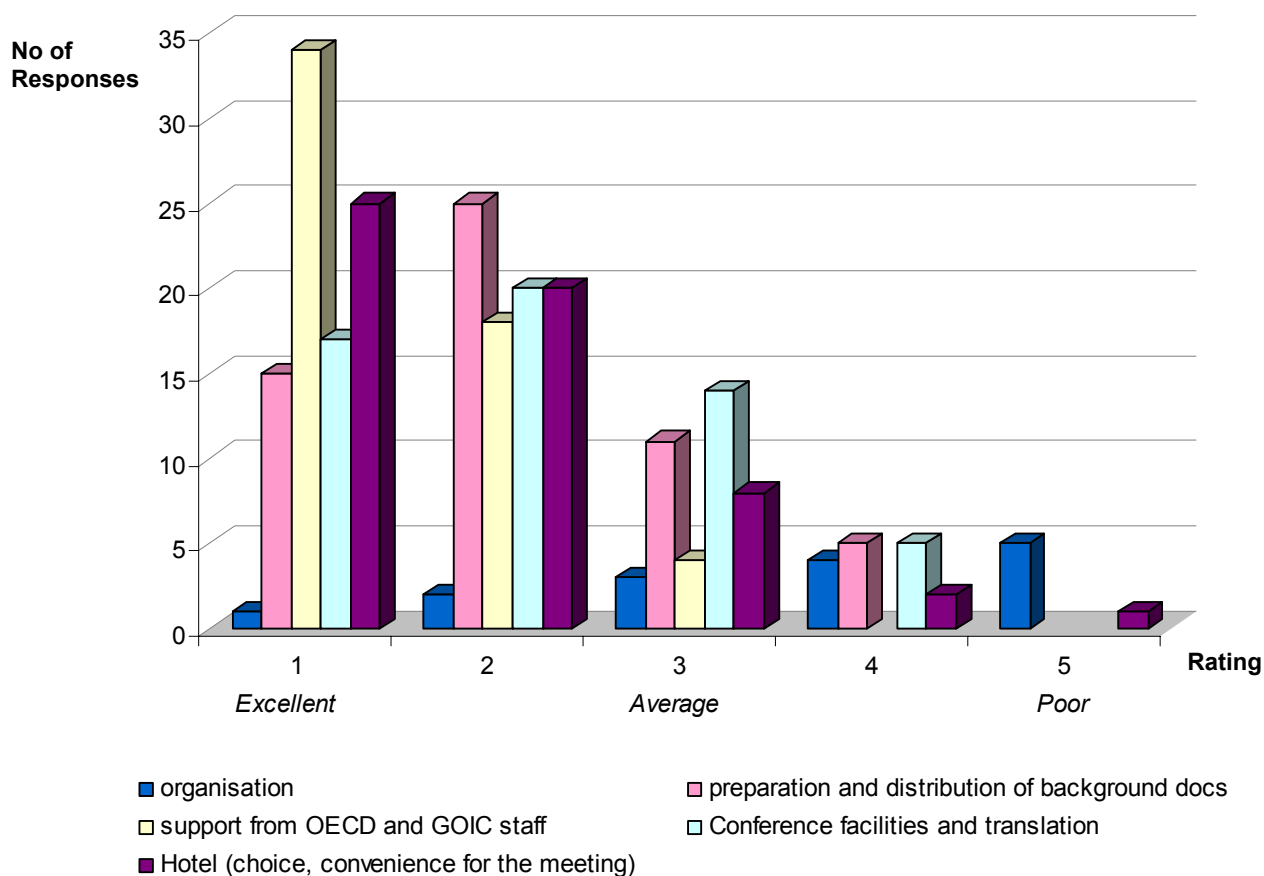
How participants have rated the background material, the discussions, the structure of the dialogue...

IV. COMMENTS & SUGGESTIONS

As the above survey results show the majority of participants was very satisfied with the meeting. Still, participants did make some comments which were mostly relating to time and organisational issues, such as possibly too many presentations, not enough time for dialogue, and lack of punctuality. Some also felt more private sector representatives and those outside the trade and aid community should have attended this meeting. Others commented that the event could have focused more on implementation-related issues, and that the quality of speakers varied greatly.
