Aims

The aims are threefold. Raison d'être

As a training institute the EAL focuses on improving legislation and regulatory governance both at national and European level, as well as legislation within international institutions. So far, this area is not sufficiently addressed at other European universities and institutes. For this reason, contact between professionals and sharing best practices with regard to legislative systems and processes in various European countries, countries in development and transition, European institutions and international organizations, play a central role at the EAL.

Programmes

The EAL provides for expert meetings, colloquia and is currently co-developing a full LL.M. curriculum (also in an e-learning environment). This refers to subjects perceived as relevant in the contexts of national administrations, European institutions and international organizations. The subjects will be addressed under the denominators of 'legislative theory, legislative processes, legislative methods and legislative drafting techniques'. An integral approach to legislation, a comparative perspective and a fruitful mix of theory and practice are trademarks of the activities of the EAL.

Target audience

The EAL targets on legislative professionals (counsel, drafters, policy advisors, civil servants) employed in national administrations, parliaments, European institutions and international organizations. In Europe, and beyond.

Special programmes can be tailored and developed in close conjunction with governmental agencies or international institutions on request. The content is demand driven: programmes are based on the practical requirements of the client and are primarily focused on training, coaching, consultancy, peer-review and -assistance.
